Sir :

It being desirable that this Department should be early apprized of the various General Orders issued by General Officers Commanding abroad which bear either directly or indirectly upon the military expenditures of the country, I have the honor to acquaint you that copies of all General Orders issued within the previous month are to be appended to the Monthly Return transmitted to this Office with the exception of such of them only as relate to Parades and other matters of purely Military Discipline not involving the movement of Officers or Men or in any other respect creating expense

Copies of the proceedings and detailed Evidence before Courts Martial being voluminous need not be sent.

It is clear from this despatch that these volumes do not include a all general orders issued.

Most, if not all, of the orders in these volumes can be found in their original form in the series of General Orders in RG 8 , "C" Series , Volumes C1194 - C1194 F.

The orders are arranged chronologically.

Volume 289 - General Orders. Nova Scotia , 1841 - 1851. These orders are similar in nature form, origin and organization to those in volumes 268 - 269.

Beginning in October 1846 there is a separate series for New - Brunswick.

Volumes 303 - 317 - General Orders, Canada 1811 - 1817. This series does not appear to have been prepared in as selective a manner as volumes 268, 269, and 289. It seems to contain copies of most, if not all of the general orders which are to be found in RG 8, "C" Series. Volume C - 1168 - C1177.

The arrangement is basically chronological although in some cases the volumes overlap.
