INTRODUCTION

The finding aid to the Kenneth Porter Kirkwood fonds is divided in two parts: the first part (p. 1-14) describes the material donated to the National Archives of Canada in 1970, 1971, 1972 and 1976; the second part (p. 15-52) describes the bulk of the Kirkwood papers which were donated in 1990.

Documents donated in 1990

The arrangement of this material of the Kirkwood fonds basically follows the organization done on the papers by the wife of K.P. Kirkwood, Mrs. Christine Kirkwood, after the death of her husband. A copy of her inventory and subject guide to these papers can be found in volume 11, file 22. A list of correspondents drawn up by Christine Kirkwood is found at the end of the finding aid. Researchers should use this list with caution because it has not been verified for accuracy.
