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INTRODUCTION

Volumes 1 to 103 and 179 of the R.A. Bell papers were donated to the National Archives in 1968. Volumes 104 to 178 were donated in 1988.

The arrangement of the newer material was patterned after the arrangement of the existing material. That is, in series, with each series depicting a distinct period in Mr. Bell's life. Within each series, files have been arranged alphabetically. The only exception to this is the Department of Citizenship and Immigration Series where the departmental numerical filing system has been retained.

It is therefore quite possible that a specific subject may be located in more than one series. An example of this would be the Progressive Conservative Party. References to the Party may be found in almost every Series.
