Papers collected by Ogle R. Gowan (1796-1876), first Grand Master and Sovereign of the Grand Orange Lodge in Canada, who organized the Grand Lodge in 1830 at the town of Brockville; his son-in-law, Thomas R. Ferguson (1818-1879), Member of the House of Commons for Cardwell, Ontario, 1867-1872, and by Ferguson's children and grand-children. Most of the material concerns the history of the Orange Order in Canada especially in Ontario and the prairie provinces, and the political careers of Ogle Robert Gowan and Thomas Robert Ferguson.

Acquired in 1970 from Mr. S.C. Ferguson of London, Ont.

Finding Aid No. 623 consists of a author, date, and subject list for correspondence, a list of pamphlets and printed matter; a descriptive file list of other items.

One photograph of Ogle R. Gowan and two photographs of an Orange meeting in Calgary were transferred to the National Photography Collection. Broadsides and circulars are in the vertical filing cabinet, and described in volume 8 to 23

Correspondence, 1826-1930. Originals, 3 cm; photocopies, 2 cm (volume 1).

Correspondence of Ogle R. Gowan, T.R. Ferguson and other members of the Gowan-Ferguson family, relating to Orangeism, Militia, politics, and patronage. Of particular interest are a collection of letters written by John A. Macdonald to Ogle R. Gowan and T.R. Ferguson between 1847-1860, and extracts of letters, 1845-1847, from O.R. Gowan to William Morris, Provincial Secretary.

Speeches, 1825-1934. 5 cm (volume 2).

Speeches of Ogle R. Gowan and other members of the Gowan-Ferguson family relating to the Orange

Order, religion, politics, and miscellaneous subjects.

Several speeches are undated and in many instances the author is not identified. A large number of the speeches appear to have been delivered by Ogle R. Gowan while the majority of the speeches between 1890-1934 were probably delivered by Gowan's grandson, A.D. Ferguson, before Orange gatherings in Western Canada.

Pamphlets and printed matter, n.d., 1826-1958. Originals, 10cm (volume 3 and vertical files, Manuscript Division).

A collection of pamphlets concerning Orangeism and Orange causes and a number of broadsides relating to the Orange Order and election campaigns of O.R. Gowan and T.R. Ferguson. The finding aid contains a list of pamphlets.

Scrapbooks. Originals, 20 cm (volumes 4-5).

Two scrapbooks of clippings concerning speeches and activities of the Orange Order in Canada, chiefly in Canada West and Ontario, 1850-1880. Other newspaper besides scrapbooks are included in these volumes.

A third scrapbook is serialized work entitled Memoirs of the Rebellion of Canada. The author and the newspaper are not identified and the work is undated.

Memorabilia. Originals, 10 cm (volume 6).

These are museum objects and include Orange Order regalia, the Gowan family seal, a leather wallet of the invader who tried to kill Gowan during the Battle of the Windmill in 1838. (The contents of this volume have been transferred to the Museum of Civilization)

Miscellaneous, n.d., 1826-1918. Originals, 10cm (volume 7).

Among the miscellaneous items are: the muster roll of Ogle R. Gowan's Queen's Own Rifles, n.d.; the words to Col. Gowan's March, n.d.; membership certificates in the Orange Lodge, 1842; genealogical material concerning the Gowan-Ferguson family, n.d.; a business account book of T.R. Ferguson, 1857; copies of despatches from Lt.-Gov. Sir George Arthur to Marquess of Normanby, Secretary of State for War and the Colonies, concerning Arthur's suspicion of the Orange Association and of Gowan, its

leader, 1839; minutes of the Religious Tract and Book Society for Ireland, 10 April 1826, of the Hiberman Bible Society, 13 April 1826, and of the Hiberman Church Missionary Society, 14 April 1826; material relating to Gowan's work as a licence inspector in Toronto, 1867-1874l Other items are listed in finding aid.
