The Montreal Amateur Athletic Association was formed as a union of the Montreal Snowshoe Club (founded 1840), the Montreal Lacrosse Club (founded 1856) and the Montreal Bicycle Club (founded 1878), and formally incorporated 20 June 1881 by an Act of the Quebec Legislature. By 1890 there were five affiliated clubs -- the original three plus the Toboggan Club and the Montreal Football Club -- as well as various "connected" clubs such as the Montreal Hockey Club, the Drama Club, Chess Club, Cinderella Club (a social club), Fencing Club and Boxing Club. The three founding clubs purchased the Montreal Gymnasium at the time of the founding of the MAAA, and in purchasing the Gymnasium also acquired the library of the Mercantile Library Association which had occupied space in the building since 1871. The playing fields of the MAAA, used first for lacrosse and later for football, were among the finest in Montreal. In 1905 when the MAAA moved to its new clubhouse, their original grounds were rented to McGill University and were ultimately sold to the City of Westmount in The new clubhouse included a swimming pool, gymnasium, bowling alleys, billiard rooms, a library, apartments, and a dining room. Squash courts and indoor tennis facilities were later added as the MAAA expanded its facilities to meet changing trends in sports. The MAAA still occupies this clubhouse on Peel Street, in the heart of downtown Montreal.

Finding Aid No. 738 provides a list of file titles for the whole collection (except for material in vertical storage) and detailed references for the minute books of the MAAA, the Montreal Hockey Club, Canadian Amateur Hockey League and the Montreal Football Club.

The collection is a composite of the various member organizations and is divided into series as follows:

Montreal Amateur Athletic Association, n.d., 1881-1934. 95 cm (volumes 1-5).

Minutebooks, 1881-1934, of the MAAA containing minutes of meetings of directors, nomination of members, maintenance of the buildings and grounds, acquisition of equipment, appointments and salaries of staff and financial information. Also included are: the MAAA Building Committee Minute Book, 1900-1905, containing the minutes of the committee charged with acquiring the necessary land, obtaining plans and having the new clubhouse built; the Souvenir Booklet prepared for the opening of the clubhouse in 1905; scrapbook of newspaper advertisements placed by the MAAA and its various clubs, c.1887-1894; and correspondence and minutebook of the Bowling Committee, n.d, 1909-1924.

Montreal Hockey Club, 1893-1931, 1950. 10 cm (volume 6). Minutebooks, 1893-1931, relating to the administration and activities of the Club and containing information on the Club's finances, purchases of equipment and information about games played. Also included are a Cash Book, 1901-1903, containing the expenses of the Club prior to its affiliation with the MAAA, constitution and by-laws, and miscellaneous correspondence, c.1901-1906, 1950.

Canadian Amateur Hockey League, 1898-1907. 8 cm (volume 6). In 1898 the Quebec, Ottawa, Victoria, Montreal and McGill hockey clubs withdrew from the Amateur Hockey Association of Canada and formed the Canadian Amateur Hockey League (CAHL). Included are minutes of annual and executive meetings and schedules of games for each year. The accounts of the CAHL are contained in the Treasurer's Book, 1898-1907, and include expenses for trips to games, normal business expenses, delegates expenses to Amateur Athletic Association meetings, annual dues and the cost of trophy engraving. The constitution of several hockey clubs are also included, as are the names of various other clubs. The CAHL was disbanded in 1907.

Montreal Football Club, 1872-1930. 21 cm (volumes 6-7, 8).

Minutebooks, 1872-1929, containing information about games played, lists of players and the development of the rules of the game. Also included are annual reports, the constitution and bylaws and clippings about the Club's activities. Scrapbook for 1894, 1899-1902. Correspondence, 1920-1930.

Montreal Snowshoe Club, 1861-1941. 21 cm (volumes 7-8).

Minutebooks, 1861-1941, providing detailed information on excursions, reports on annual races, newspaper clippings, ribbons and broadsides. Also included is a history of the Club published in 1882.

Montreal Toboggan and Skating Club, 1890-1911. 6 cm (volume 9). Minutebooks documenting the running of the MAAA rink and its uses by other Clubs, and other activities of the Toboggan and Skating Club.

Montreal Lacrosse Club, 1884–1911. 14 cm (volume 9).

Minutebooks, 1886–1899, 1904–1911, and a leaflet recording results of championships held under the National Amateur Lacrosse Association of Canada during 1866–1884. Two posters relating to tours of Great Britain by Euro-Canadian and Iroquois Indian lacrosse teams, dated May 1876 and June /1876?/, have been placed in vertical storage. A third poster advertising a match before the royal family, June 1876, was photographed when the MAAA papers were in the custody of the Public Archives of Canada during 1971–1978. This third poster was not returned in 1983 but copies may be obtained (subject to the access restrictions on papers) from the photographic negative, number C-88603.

Minutebook containing the letters patent and list of shareholders, and documenting the construction and operation of the gymnasium and its sale to the MAAA.
