Stanbury, Richard J. (1923-), 1908-1998; predominant 1965-1998, 34 vols, Finding Aid no 896, 5.15 m of textual records

Richard J. Stanbury was born in Exeter Ontario and later moved to Toronto, where he still lives. He attended the University of Western Ontario and Osgoode Hall. In 1944 Stanbury married Margaret Walker and they had two children, Jane and Sally. He was called to the Ontario Bar in 1948 and practised law with the Toronto firm of Cassels, Brock and Blackwell. Stanbury was appointed Q.C. in 1961. He became actively involved in the Liberal Federation of Canada (now the Liberal Party of Canada) after its defeat to the Conservatives in 1958. Stanbury was President of the Toronto and District Liberal Association (1960-1964), a member of the Liberal Federation Campaign Committee (1961-1967), President of the Liberal Federation of Canada (1968-1973), Chairman of the Treasury Committee (1974-1976) and Co-Chairman of the 1984 Leadership Convention's Candidates Expenses Committee. He was summoned to the Senate 13 February 1968.

As a Senator, Stanbury was involved with several committees including the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Committee as both Chairman and Co-Chairman, the Joint Commons/Senate Committee on Conflict of Interest as Co-Chairman and he was the Chairman of the Special Committee on the Constitution. He promoted the development of Canadian trade overseas and founded the Canada-Arab Business Council, the Canada-Taiwan Trade Council, the Canada-India Business Council in the early and mid 1970s and sat on the International Affairs Committee of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce. The Senator was also a member of the Liberal International. Stanbury chaired the Presbyterian Church Building Corporation for twenty years and sat on the Board of Directors of Rogers Communications and Beneficial Finance Company of Canada. He retired from the Senate in May 1998.

This fonds documents Stanbury's political life, particularly as a Liberal and as a Senator. Stanbury was active in the Liberal Party of Canada, especially from 1968-1976, and his records document the politics of the Party at this time. These records include annotated agendas and minutes, notes and commentaries of National and Leadership conventions, and correspondence with many prominent Liberals of the time. Stanbury's commitment to liberalism is documented through many of his speeches and through his activities with the Liberal International - an organization which seeks to foster and strengthen *laissez-faire* economic and social policies that do not neglect the public good. Stanbury's extensive travels, some with the Liberal International and some to promote Canadian trade, are documented in twenty years of travel diaries. His Senate activities are largely documented in an alphabetical subject series that includes correspondence, research material, annotated agenda and

Stanbury's religious convictions are documented through his speeches and personal files relating to his activities with the Presbyterian Church.

This fonds is arranged into eight series and four sub-series: Correspondence Series; Speech Series; Liberal Party of Canada Series which includes the Subject Sub-Series, the National Executive Sub-Series, the Treasury Committee Sub-Series, and the Conventions Sub-Series; Liberal International Series; Senate Office Subject Series; Research Series; and Personal Series.

1) CORRESPONDENCE SERIES: 1968-1984, Vols. 1-4, 16-17, 65cm

This series consists of in/out correspondence from Stanbury's Senate office arranged into two blocks. The first block includes chronologically arranged correspondence written or received while Stanbury was President of the federal Liberal Party from 1968-1973. The second includes letters arranged chronologically from 1968-1984, by political office, such as correspondence with Prime minister Trudeau, Trudeau's Ministers, Trudeau's Staff, and with other Senators.

The different arrangement of the two blocks of correspondence reflects how they were received from Stanbury's office on two occasions in 1973 and 1998.

Correspondence is found throughout most of his files - not just those in the correspondence series.

2) SPEECHES SERIES: n.d., 1962-1986, 1993, 1997, Vols. 9, 17, 20cm

This series consists of speeches given by Stanbury in various capacities including as a Senator, a Liberal or as a member of the Presbyterian Church, to institutions such as schools, trade associations, church and community groups. Includes drafts, annotated and final versions of speeches. Speeches are arranged chronologically into two blocks. Only three speeches are later than 1984.

Other speeches and drafts may be found under "Senate" and "Speeches" in volumes 31 and 32 of the Senate Office Subject Series.

3) LIBERAL PARTY OF CANADA SERIES: 1964-1984, Vols. 5-8, 10-14, 17-23, 2.1m

This series consists of correspondence, agendas, minutes and memoranda, much of it annotated. Correspondents include Pierre Trudeau, Gildas Molgat, Blair Williams, Torrance Wylie and

John Godfrey. The records are organized to reflect how they were maintained in Stanbury's office and are arranged into four sub-series: 1) Subject Sub-Series; 2) National Executive Sub-Series; 3) Treasury Committee Sub-Series and 4) Conventions Sub-Series.

1) Subject Sub-series: n.d., 1968-1976, 1986-1988, Vols. 5-8, 10-14, 17-19, 1.3m

This sub-series consists of reports, correspondence, and clippings. Records document a wide range of subjects including Stanbury's policy work; requests for contracts; recommendations for appointments; election strategies; surveys and federal advertising.

There are three separate groupings of subject files which relate to the Liberal Party. These groups contain the same kinds of records, generated by the same kinds of activities, but were accessioned on three separate occasions.

Other records created by Stanbury's activities with the Liberal Party are found in the Senate Office Subject Series.

2) National Executive Sub-series: 1968-1976, Vols. 19-20, 30cm

This sub-series consists of agendas and minutes (some of which are annotated), correspondence, policy papers and reports. Files from 1968-1973, while Stanbury was President, contain reports from committees, individuals, and Liberal organizations along with memoranda and correspondence labelled "confidential".

3) Treasury Committee Sub-series: n.d., 1964-1976, Vols. 21-22, 35cm

This sub-series consists of financial statements, budgets, memoranda, agendas, correspondence and reports. It includes a few dozen letters from 1972-1976 from John Godfrey, then Chairman of the Ontario Federal Liberal Finance Committee and former Chairman of the Treasury Committee.

4) Conventions Sub-series: 1968-1973, 1984, Vols. 22-23, 20cm

This sub-series consists of agendas and minutes (some of which are annotated), correspondence and memos, and committee reports from National Meetings and Leadership Conventions. Also includes material from policy sessions, draft policies, and ballots.

4) LIBERAL INTERNATIONAL SERIES: 1968-1991, Vols. 23-27, 65cm

The Liberal International, also known as the World Liberal Union, exists to strengthen relations among liberal political parties. Senator Stanbury was most active in the organization from the late 1960s to the late 1970s.

This series consists of three groups of records. It includes conference files arranged chronologically with correspondence, agendas, policy papers, and travel records which document

Stanbury's participation in international congresses; general files arranged chronologically with correspondence, newsletters and other related materials; and subject files which document Stanbury's interest in such areas as human rights, education, and fundraising.

5) DIARIES AND MANUSCRIPTS SERIES: 1968-1986, 1993, Vols. 13, 27, 20cm

This series consists of travel diaries (1974-1993) which document Stanbury's social, political, and cultural observations of his international travels. It also includes political diaries which document Stanbury's private comments on the leadership convention and national election of 1968, his account of the source of a leaked document in December 1971, and conversations surrounding his position as Chairman of the Liberal Party's Treasury Committee in May 1974. This series also includes two book-length manuscripts written in 1969 on the Liberal Party entitled the *Liberal Party of Canada:* An Interpretation and the Liberal Party of Canada Through the Eyes of Dick Stanbury. These are followed by correspondence and critiques on these drafts.

6) SENATE OFFICE SUBJECT SERIES: 1908-1998; predominant 1967-1998, Vols. 15, 28-32, 95cm

This series consists of subject files kept in Stanbury's Senate office. They are organized somewhat alphabetically as they were kept in the office. These records document Stanbury's activities in the Senate and to a lesser extent, the liberal Party. The files cover a range of subjects and include correspondence, memoranda and agendas, some of which are annotated. They also include reference material resulting from Stanbury's participation in Senate committees and special issues such as the GST Crisis. This series also documents Stanbury's attitudes towards the Senate as an institution through completed surveys and responses to concerned private citizens. Also included is a poster of the "Total Trade of the Dominion of Canada, For Each Fiscal Year 1868-1908".

7) **REASERCH SERIES:** n.d., 1989-1993, Vols. 32-33, 20cm

This series consists of briefing books, research notes, committee agendas and minutes, clippings, and correspondence created by Stanbury, his research assistant Craig Bedford and by Parliamentary researcher Barbara Kagedan. Also includes papers and briefs by the Library of Parliament's Research Branch as requested by Stanbury. The majority of records are related to Stanbury's positions as Chairman of the Senate's Legal and Consitutional Affairs Committee and as Co-Chairman of the

Special Joint Committee on Conflicts of Interest. Research materials are related to two main issues: the objection of the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Committee to the appointment of Bruce Phillips as Privacy Commissioner in June 1990; and Bill C-43, Members of the Senate and House of Commons Conflict of Interest Act, which includes background material

on witnesses before the Committee. Other research notes and briefs corver such issues as abortion, the Oka Crisis, and referendum legislation.

8) PERSONAL SERIES: 1932-1998; predominant 1969-1993, Vols. 33-34, 15cm

This series consists of records relating to Stanbury's involvement with the Presbyterian Church, his poems, personal clippings and personal correspondence. Stanbury's activities with the Presbyterian Church Building Corporation and the Church's International Affairs Committee are documented along with clippings and correspondence related to church matters (1968-1998). This series also includes humorous poems written by Stanbury for political friends and for family correspondence includes letters to and from falily members, correspondence with fellow Masons, and letters of congratulations after he was appointed to the Senate.
