INTRODUCTION

The subject files in the Hon. J. Angus MacLean collection were maintained in a three-digit block numeric system. Reading from left to right, one moves from the umbrella group to the specific subject. For example:

> designates government departments designates Veterans Affairs file 1-19-2:

19

designates War Veteran's Allowances

In addition, some files are further divided by writer or organization concerned; however, these were not assigned an additional number.

It will be apparent that some numbers within certain blocks are "missing". In some cases the files were either not received or not retained, as their contents were readily available elsewhere. In other cases, such as the complaints regarding the closing of Post Offices (1-9), only a representative sample was retained.

Finally, some files have large gaps in their dates. In 1974, MacLean deposited most of his files at the Public Archives of Canada and, after the 1974 election, the same system was begun again. As the systems were virtually identical, the two donations of subject files were integrated into one uniform series. For this reason, a file which was dormant in 1972 may also contain material dated from 1974 with nothing for the intervening year(s).
