INTRODUCTION

The collection consists of material which had been accumulated at the national headquarters prior to the association's fifth national conference in 1953. Geroge Tanaka, former national executive secretary, was given the responsibility of collecting the J.C.C.A. records. The records include the following: material related to the activities of the Japanese Canadian Committee for Democracy (J.C.C.D.) 1944 to 1947, the J.C.C.A. 1947 to 1953, and the Co-operative Committee on Japanese Canadians (C.C.J.C.) 1946 to 1950. Subsequently additional material was added to this core collection. This additional material includes: the minutes of the Japanese Canadian Citizens League (J.C.C.L.) Vancouver chapter 1936 to 1940, records of the Japanese Canadian Citizens Council (J.C.C.C.) 1942, the British Columbia J.C.C.A. minutes 1946 to 1948, and material relating to the J.C.C.D. 1943 to 1945. Also added was material concerning the J.C.C.A. 1954 to 1975 in 1976.

This Finding Aid is both a file list and a conversion list. The numbers appearing in the left hand margin give the volume and the file number. The number in the right hand margin (prefixed C-) given the microfilm reel number.
