Dominion Archivist and National Librarian

Biographical

Dr. Lamb was born in New Westminster, British Columbia. He completed undergraduate studies in History at the University of British Columbia. From 1928 to 1932, he studied in Paris under a Nichol Scholarship. The interruption of this work for the completion of an M.A. in History, 1930, set him on a new path of research which led to his completion of a doctoral degree in economics and history from the University of London, England, 1933.

Despite the Depression, the young scholar found employment in 1934 in Victoria as the Provincial Librarian and Archivist of British Columbia. From 1936 to 1940 he was also the Superintendent of the province's Public Library Commission. He became the Librarian of the University of British Columbia in 1940. During this stage of his career, Dr. Lamb was active on numerous boards and societies, contributed to historical, library and marine periodicals, and was editor of the *British Columbia Historical Quarterly, 1937-1946*. Building on these foundations over the years, a list grew which included executive membership on the Canadian Historical Association, the Champlain society, the Canadian Library Association, the Society of American Archivists, the Royal Society of Canada, and the Bibliographical Society of Canada.

The appointment of Dr. Lamb as Dominion Archivist signalled a new period of expansion, modernization and change for the Public Archives of Canada. By 1950, the holdings of the Archives had been reorganized into manuscript and record groups and publication of preliminary inventories was underway. The use of microfilm was introduced in 1950. Three years later, the National Library was founded. Lamb had officially campaigned for this institution since 1946 when he was elected Vice-President of the Canadian Library Association. Dr. Lamb retired as Dominion Archivist on 15 January 1969.

Arrangement

The papers of Dr. W. Kaye Lamb are arranged alphabetically by subject. The contents of each file are chronologically arranged. Miscellaneous files are placed at the beginning of each alphabetical group.

Transferred Material

Material which is not textual in nature has been largely transferred to the appropriate media division. This includes the maps and photographs.

1) The National Map Collection (accession no. 86703/5) has received a microfilm copy of plans, 1954, for the National Library, as well as a map dated 1937 entitled "Land Record Districts", B.C.; and a map, n.d., Methy Portage, La Loche, Saskatchewan.

2) The National Photograph Collection (accession no. 1986-094) has received miscellaneous photographs and a photo album of the John Galt Family, originally owned by Charles A. Magrath.

3) Five photographs of Dr. Lamb receiving a doctorate of laws, honoris causa, from McMaster University, 1966, were transferred to the appropriate division in 1998.
