## **BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION**

Leon Kronitz was born in Kletzk, Poland. After graduating from the Kletzker Yeshiva and the Tarbut Teachers' Seminary in Vilna, he emigrated to Canada in 1938. He settled in Montreal where he received his B.A. from McGill University in 1944. In 1969 he received his doctorate in education from the Jewish Theological Seminary of America. His thesis was titled, "The Education of Jewish Children in the Province of Quebec."

A leading authority on Jewish day school education in North America, Dr. Kronitz was the founding principal of the Herzliah High School, 1945-1948 and principal of the Solomon Schechter Academy of Montreal, 1955-1972. He was one of the first five Jewish representatives appointed by the Quebec government to the Protestant School Board of Greater Montreal, 1955-1972. During this time he served as an officer of the Canadian Jewish Congress and was chairman of its executive committee. Dr. Kronitz promoted the use of the Hebrew language amongst all segments of the Jewish community. He was national executive director of Keren Hatarbut-The Hebrew Culture Organization of Canada, 1948-1955. He brought to Canada the idea of creating Hebrew-speaking camps for children and helped found Camp Massad of Canada.

A life-long Zionist, Dr. Kronitz served as national president of the Labor Zionist Movement of Canada for three terms, 1963-1973. He established Viewpoints under its auspices and was chairman of the editorial board, 1965-1976. He was one of the founders of the Canadian Zionist Federation and in April 1973, he became executive vice-president of the C.Z.F., a position he held until his death. He headed the C.Z.F.'s Department of Education and Culture and was editor of the Canadian Zionist, the C.Z.F.'s monthly magazine.

On the international level, Dr. Kronitz was chairman of the Cultural Commission of the World Jewish Congress and a member of its Board of Governors. He was a deputy member of the Actions Committee of the World Zionist Organization and attended many of its congresses. He was chairman of its Reorganization Commission in 1965-1966. He participated in many of the Jewish Agency assemblies in Jerusalem.

Dr. Leon Kronitz died in 1985.

## **RESEARCH POTENTIAL**

The Public Archives of Canada's impressive collection of records pertaining to the Zionist movement in Canada has been augmented by new material found in the Leon Kronitz Papers. The uniqueness and historical significance of this material is derived from the documentation of the major issues which affected the Jewish community and its support for Israel and the Zionist cause since the 1940's. Of special interest are the records found in the Canadian Zionist Federation series. The C.Z.F. whose mandate is to promote the Zionist ideal in Canada, includes organizations aligned with Israeli political parties and affiliated with Jewish religious movements as well as the Hadassah-WIZO Organization of Canada. Dr. Kronitz was a skilled politician who was able to unite these diverse elements within the Federation and also administer its programme. Because of his background as an educator within the Jewish day school system in Montreal, a great part of the collection is devoted to the development of Jewish education and Jewish youth literature in Canada.
