#### INTRODUCTION

The papers were donated in 1983, 1985, 1986 and 1987 by Mrs. Louise de Kiriline Lawrence. The papers are organized in ten volumes and each volume is a box containing approximately 20 cm. of files. The original illustrations and photographs were transferred to the Documentary Art and Photography Division.

This collection is of particular interest to researchers in the natural history of Northern Ontario. The material is also of interest to researchers in Scandinavian Canadian history.

#### **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Louise Vendela Augusta Jana Flach was born in Sweden in 1894. Her Danish mother and Swedish father, being well-to-do, conferred upon her all the advantages that their wealth and influence could provide. One of these was a proper education, which included a grounding in other languages. A good student, Louise Flach became fluent in five languages--Swedish, Danish, English, French and Russian.

During the First World War, Louise Flach enlisted as a Red Cross nurse in neutral Denmark. While serving at a prisoner-of-war exchange camp there, she met a wounded Russian army officer, G.N. Kirilin, whom she nursed back to health. The two fell in love, married, and then left for Archangel in northern Russia, where she served as a war nurse and he as a liaison officer between the Russian White Army and British Expeditionary Forces. With the final collapse and ruin of the White offensive in Russia, Kirilin disappeared along with thousands of other Russians who had opposed the Bolsheviks' rise to power. Determined to ferret out the fate of her missing husband, Louise de Kiriline spent some four years in Soviet Russia, first as a nurse at a children's hospital and then with the Nansen Swedish Relief Mission, all the while continuing her search for him until every avenue of hope had been exhausted. Her return to Sweden was brief, for she decided to emigrate in 1927, "com[ing] to Canada, not to nurse a broken heart, but to tend something new that impetuously pressed through to live out of the shattered fragments of a lost episode. And of all countries I chose Canada, because she, I knew, possessed the unspoiled soil, the life-giving space, the fresh winds that promote spontaneous growth" (Louise de Kiriline, "Why Did You Come to Canada?" Chatelaine, October 1937, p. 53). Indeed as her subsequent activities here attest, Louise de Kiriline had come to build a new life for herself.

Shortly after her arrival, she was put in charge of a Red Cross outpost in Northern Ontario. She then won celebrity as a nurse to the Dionne quintuplets. Moreover, because of the public's insatiable curiosity with the Dionnes, Louise de Kiriline launched herself into a new career as a popular magazine writer with a *Chatelaine* series on her experiences with the quints. She married Leonard Lawrence in 1939. After his enlistment into the Canadian Army to serve overseas, Louise de Kiriline Lawrence threw her energies into bird-banding and other activities allied with nature

#### conservation.

She was first encouraged by P.A. Taverner--then head of the Ornithological Division at the National Museum--to become a professional in the study of Canadian fauna. Taking his advice to heart, she began to use scientific techniques in her study of birds native to the forests of northern Ontario. Before long, she was writing popular and learned articles based on her findings. The culmination of Louise de Kiriline Lawrence's ornithological career came in 1967 with the publication of *A Comparative Life-History Study of Four Species of Woodpeckers*. As *The Ontario Naturalist* was to say of this book: "Major ornithological studies by residents of Ontario are few and far between; the present publication is one of the most important ever to originate in this Province."
