INTRODUCTION

The finding aid to the John King Gordon papers comprises three main sections: an introduction with biographical information on Gordon and an overview of the papers; a topographical file list; and an index to the file list. The index will refer researchers to names of individuals, organizations, and places in the file list. Two types of documents have also been indexed: diaries and Gordon's speeches and writings (the latter under "Gordon, J. King - speeches and writings").

John King Gordon: Biographical Information

John King Gordon was born on 6 December 1900 at Winnipeg, Manitoba, and was raised there by his parents, Helen Skinner (King) Gordon and the Reverend Charles W. Gordon (also known as the novelist Ralph Connor). As a student at the University of Manitoba, King Gordon attended the Student Volunteer Movement conference at Des Moines, Iowa. He graduated with a bachelor's degree from the University of Manitoba in 1920, and proceeded the following year to Oxford University where he studied as a Rhodes Scholar, receiving a BA and an MA. Gordon's lifelong interest in international affairs began at Oxford. He was active in the League of Nations Union, served as general secretary of the Oxford International Assembly, and was the Canadian Student Christian Movement's delegate to the 1922 European Student Relief Conference at Turnov, Czechoslovakia. Returning to Canada in 1924, Gordon was engaged by the Presbyterian Church as a student minister in Giscome, British Columbia; his charge included several lumber camps and mill towns. He left Giscome in 1925 to enrol in theology at Manitoba College, Winnipeg, but in 1926 was sent to serve as minister for the United Church of Canada in Pine Falls, Manitoba, a company town owned by the Manitoba Paper Company. He continued his studies from Pine Falls, receiving a diploma in theology in 1927.

King Gordon left Pine Falls in 1929 to continue his theological studies at Union Theological Seminary (UTS) in New York. He was a member of the Agenda Club, an activist group at UTS, and came into contact with American religious and political radicals such as Reinhold Niebuhr, Harry F. Ward, Jim Dombrowski, and the League for Industrial Democracy. While attending UTS, Gordon also served as a minister at First Presbyterian Church in Bloomfield, New Jersey.

After his appointment in 1931 as professor of Christian Ethics at United Theological College in Montreal, King Gordon returned to Canada and soon became a prominent figure in the growing socialist movement.

With Eugene Forsey and J.A. Coote, he established the Committee on Social and Economic Research of the United Church's Montreal Presbytery. Gordon was an early member of the Montreal Branch of the League for Social Reconstruction. He worked with the LSR's Research Bureau and was a co-author of the LSR's major statement, Social Planning for Canada (1935). A founding member of the Co-operative Commonwealth Federation, Gordon had a hand in drafting the Regina Manifesto, and took part in the CCF's 1933 founding convention at Regina and in important discussions prior to the convention. He served on the party's national executive until 1938. During the early 1930s Gordon made two visits to the USSR: with Eugene Forsey in 1932, and leading a group consisting largely of ministers in 1934.

The United Theological College dismissed King Gordon from the Christian Ethics Chair in 1934, an action which proved controversial. The college's budget was given as the reason, although there was little doubt at the time that Gordon's political activity had led to his dismissal. An organization of socialist ministers and lay people, the Fellowship for a Christian Social Order, soon hired Gordon as its travelling secretary. He held this position until 1938, delivering numerous lectures, speeches and sermons across Canada and in the United States and contributing a chapter to the FCSO's book, Towards the Christian Revolution (1936). His association with the CCF continued when he unsuccessfully contested the federal riding of Victoria (BC) in the 1935 general election and in by-elections in 1936 and 1937 (coming within 90 votes of winning in 1936).

The death of his father in 1937 led indirectly to King Gordon's second move to the United States. Farrar and Rinehart, a New York publishing company, was planning to publish C.W. Gordon's autobiography at the time of his death. King Gordon was brought in to complete the editing and to write the introduction. After the publication of Postscript to Adventure: The Autobiography of Ralph Connor in 1938, King Gordon accepted Farrar and Rinehart's offer of a position as non-fiction editor. In 1939 he married Ruth Anderson, another Farrar and Rinehart editor; together they had two children. During 1942-1943 Gordon was a member of the Royal Commission on the Steel Industry which the federal government appointed to investigate wage rates in steel plants in Sault Ste Marie, Ontario, and Sydney, Nova Scotia. He wrote a minority report favouring the steel workers. In 1944 Gordon left Farrar and Rinehart to become managing editor of The Nation, a liberal newsmagazine based in New York. During this period in New York Gordon maintained his Canadian political contacts, and made considerable efforts to educate Americans on Canadian society and politics, and particularly the CCF (the subject of many of his speaking and writing engagements).

A major career change occurred when Gordon was let go by The Nation in 1947 following a financial crisis

and re-organization. The CBC soon offered him a job as its representative at the United Nations, and for the next three years Canadian radio listeners regularly heard Gordon's reports on UN meetings at Lake Success and in Europe. Reporting on the UN developed into working for it when in 1950 Gordon joined the UN's Division of Human Rights in New York. His work consisted largely of information, speech-writing, and publications; he also acted as secretary of the Ad Hoc Commission on Prisoners of War. In 1954 Gordon left New York to work as chief of information for the UN Korean Reconstruction Agency; his family lived in Japan. Two years later, just before the 1956 Suez Crisis, he moved to Cairo where he was director of the United Nations Information Centre for the Middle East. Following the attacks by Israel, Great Britain and France his assignment continued under General E.L.M. Burns and the UN Emergency Force, while the Gordon family was evacuated to Italy. He returned to his position at the Information Centre in May 1957. After a brief stint with the UN's Technical Assistance Administration in New York during 1959-1960, Gordon had three assignments (1960-1962) as an information officer in the emergency force which the UN sent to the Congo in response to the breakdown in civil order after independence from Belgium. His book, The United Nations in the Congo: A Quest for Peace, was published in 1962.

After his retirement from the UN in 1962, King Gordon was hired by the Political Science department of the University of Alberta, Edmonton, to teach courses in International Relations. His other activities during this period included serving as the national chairman of the Canadian University Service Overseas (1963-1969) and organizing the first Banff Conferences on World Development/Affairs. In 1967 Gordon moved to the University of Ottawa, where he was a professor of International Relations and assistant director of the Centre for International Co-operation. In 1973 he moved to the federal government's International Development Research Centre as a senior advisor on university relations. On behalf of the IDRC, Gordon maintained and expanded his already broad network of contacts in organizations working for international development and world peace. In addition to his IDRC work, other major activities included his presidency of the United Nations Association in Canada during 1974-1977 and a long association with Elisabeth Mann Borgese and the International Ocean Institute/Pacem in Maribus, an organization concerned with the conservation and management of the oceans and their resources. After leaving the IDRC in 1980, Gordon was a founding and active member of the Group of 78, an informal association of prominent Canadians that has worked for nuclear disarmament, a strengthened United Nations, and a more equitable international economic order.

Honours and awards received by King Gordon include the Order of Canada (1977), the Pearson Peace Medal (1980), and honorary degrees from Brandon University, the University of Winnipeg, Carleton University, the University of Manitoba, and St. Francis-Xavier University. King Gordon died at Ottawa on 24 February 1989.

Overview of the Papers

The John King Gordon papers are 18.60 metres in extent. The outside dates are n.d., 1834-1856, 1889, 1897-1989.

The fonds is largely organized into series that broadly follow the chronological sequence of King Gordon's life and career, although there is some overlap. The final series of personal and family material cover Gordon's whole life and are the exception to the broadly chronological pattern. Annotated file folders have been photocopied and the copy placed in the related file.

Photographs and a sketchbook of drawings by Gordon in the USSR, 1934, have been transferred to the Documentary Art and Photography Division (accessions 1989-590 and 1990-101). Oral history interviews with King Gordon are available in the Moving Images and Sound Archives Division.

The series are:

Early Life, n.d., 1905-1921. 15cm (volume 1).

Correspondence, memorabilia, diaries, scrapbook, and other material. Noteworthy is the diary of a canoe trip with his father, C.W. Gordon.

Oxford, n.d., 1918-1932, 1986-1987. 49cm (volumes 1 to 4).

Correspondence, memorabilia, notebooks, print matter, diaries, writings by Gordon, and other material. Particularly significant files are the Turnov Conference on European Student Relief, the Oxford International Assembly, and the League of Nations Union.

United Church: Giscome, British Columbia; Winnipeg; Pine Falls, Manitoba, n.d., 1922, 1924-1929, 1950 [1980s]. 30cm (volumes 4 to 5).

Autobiographical notes [1980s], correspondence pertaining to his church work as well as general and personal correspondence, appointment books, diaries, sermons, notebooks, maps, clippings and other material relating to Gordon's life and work in Giscome and Pine Falls as a Presbyterian/United Church minister and to his theological studies at Manitoba College, Winnipeg.

Union Theological Seminary and Bloomfield, New Jersey, n.d., 1916-1931 [1980s]. 27cm (volumes 5 to 7).

Autobiographical notes [1980s], correspondence pertaining to Union Theological Seminary and to First Presbyterian Church in Bloomfield (where Gordon served as a minister), general and personal correspondence, sermons, writings by Gordon, print matter, and other material. Noteworthy are the files on the UTS's work among unemployed workers (Union Waterfront Project) and Gordon's 1930 paper based on his observations of the industrial and social conditions of Pine Falls.

The 1930s and the Canadian Left, n.d., 1889, 1922-1983 [1980s]. 1.03m (volumes 7 to 12).

This series focusses on the years 1931-1938 and includes documentation on Gordon's work as professor of Christian Ethics at United Theological College, Montreal, and his dismissal; the Committee on Social and Economic Research of the Montreal Presbytery of the United Church of Canada; his position as travelling secretary of the Fellowship for a Christian Social Order; the League for Social Reconstruction; the Co-operative Commonwealth Federation; and Gordon's trips to the Soviet Union in 1932 and 1934. There are two sub-series (King Gordon's Numbered Files and alphabetical Subject Files); researchers are advised to check both. The Numbered Files are described in a detailed inventory written by Gordon in the 1980s (volume 7, file 3); numbered files 1 to 17 exist in neither Gordon's inventory nor the series. Included are: correspondence relating to Gordon's work at United Theological College, the United Church, the FCSO, the CCF, and the LSR; general and personal correspondence; memoranda; lectures,

speeches and writings by Gordon; diaries; minutes of meetings; notes; clippings about Gordon and other subjects; LSR questionnaires and Montreal membership list; draft chapters for Social Planning for Canada; a FCSO mailing list; an annotated draft of the Regina Manifesto (photocopy); and print matter. Noteworthy are the logbook of a 1931 canoe trip, the pamphlet Sandwiches "à la shouashe" from the Printing Cooperative Spartakus in Montreal, 1932, and the file of letters from Pegi Nicol (MacLeod), who became a war artist during World War II. The correspondence files often refer to Gordon's official work in addition to general and personal matters.

New York: Farrar and Rinehart, n.d., 1936-1945 [1980s]. 90cm (volumes 12 to 16).

Autobiographical notes [1980s], correspondence relating to Gordon's editing work at Farrar and Rinehart as well as general and personal correspondence, memoranda, editor's reports, Gordon's speeches and writings, print matter, and clippings. The Farrar and Rinehart files include some information on Postscript to Adventure, although most material is filed in the C.W. Gordon series below.

Royal Commission on the Steel Industry, n.d., 1930-1943. 12cm (volumes 16 to 17).

Includes correspondence, Gordon's working notebook, reports, memoranda, exhibits, reference materials, and the final report of the commission (with Gordon's minority report).

New York: The Nation, n.d., 1939-1949 [1980s]. 66cm (volumes 17 to 20).

Autobiographical notes [1980s], correspondence relating to Gordon's work for The Nation, general and personal correspondence, memoranda, speeches and writings by Gordon, print matter, and other material.

CBC Representative at the United Nations, n.d., 1942, 1946-1952 [1980s]. 58cm (volumes 20 to 23).

Autobiographical notes [1980s]; CBC, general, and personal correspondence; broadcast scripts, Atlantic Monthly reports on the UN, and other writings by Gordon; reports; memoranda; and other material.

United Nations, n.d., 1944-1988. 2.67m (volumes 23 to 36 and 94 to 95).

There is a sub-series for each phase of Gordon's UN career and one sub-series for UN-related material post-dating his 1962 retirement. The files from his career (1950-1962) include UN, general, and personal correspondence; memoranda; notebooks; reports; speeches and writings by Gordon; clippings on his UN career and other subjects; UN documents such as records of meetings, information notes, news releases, and newsletters; travel memorabilia; diaries; scripts; print matter; files on the writing of Gordon's The United Nations in the Congo (1962); and other material. Correspondents include Lester

B. Pearson, John Humphrey (director of the Human Rights Division), and other UN colleagues. The post-UN career sub-series includes retrospective files in which Gordon gives his interpretation of the Suez crisis and a 1962 CBC script in which he gives an overview of his UN career.

University Career, n.d., 1948-1951, 1963-1975. 64cm (volumes 36 to 39).

The files pertain to: Gordon's lectures for courses in International Relations and International Organization that he taught at the University of Alberta and the University of Ottawa (some of the lectures are based on his own experiences in the United Nations); administrative matters; projects and conferences of the Centre for International Co-operation at the University of Ottawa.

Canadian University Service Overseas, 1960-1977. 76cm (volumes 39 to 43).

Correspondence, minutes, reports, memoranda, newsletters, and other material on CUSO and Gordon's presidency.

United Nations Association in Canada, n.d., 1961-1982. 84cm (volumes 43 to 47).

Annual meeting files, correspondence, memoranda, minutes, material on conferences and high-school seminars in which Gordon participated, talks delivered by Gordon, and other material on the UNA in Canada and Gordon's presidency.

International Development Research Centre, n.d., 1969-1986. 87cm (volumes 47 to 52).

Correspondence, memoranda, reports by Gordon, conference and subject files, and other material. Gordon's IDRC consultancy was the main focus of his international development work during 1973-1980; his files document his extensive world-wide connections in the international development field, and contain a significant proportion of semi- or unofficial material.

International Ocean Institute and Pacem in Maribus, n.d., 1968-1987. 86cm (volumes 52 to 56).

Correspondence, memoranda, reports, studies, files on the Pacem in Maribus conferences and Planning Council meetings, project and subject files. There is extensive correspondence between Gordon and the IOI's principal organizer, Elisabeth Mann Borgese.

Group of 78, n.d., 1981-1988. 42cm (volumes 56 to 58).

Includes correspondence, memoranda, minutes, publications, and conference files. One subject documented is the Group's opposition to cruise missile testing. Correspondents include Joe Clark, Minister of External Affairs.

General Subject Files, n.d., 1923-1989. 3.33m (volumes 58 to 75).

Despite the outside dates, the General Subject Files focus on the period 1962-1989. An important set of files relates to Gordon's speeches and writings (volumes 67 to 70), including speeches and papers delivered, a few sermons, articles, letters to the editor, and major reports and memoranda. Noteworthy files are: Gordon's retrospective talks and writings on the socialist movement in the 1930s; the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada's International Development Office and its study of university resources for international development; the Banff Conferences on World Development/Affairs; and Gordon's consultancy with the Canadian International Development Agency. Several nominal files contain personal correspondence dating back as far as the 1920s with friends and associates such as Frank Scott, Frank Underhill, Graham Spry, Reinhold Niebuhr, and Jim Dombrowski.

General Correspondence and Memoranda, n.d., 1924-1958, 1962-1988. 2.27m (volumes 75 to 86).

This series deals essentially with the years after Gordon's leaving the UN; only a small number of files include material prior to 1962. The files contain both personal letters and correspondence relating to the full spectrum of Gordon's official activities after 1962, such as his university career, the IDRC, CUSO, UNA, International Ocean Institute, and Group of 78.

Personal, n.d., 1924-1987. 18cm (volumes 86-87).

Includes résumés and other autobiographical information; files on honours and awards bestowed on Gordon; and autobiographical essays and notes, diary, and other working papers for his proposed memoirs.

Family Correspondence, n.d., 1908-1974. 86cm (volumes 87 to 91).

There are two groups of files: Gordon to Family and Family to Gordon. Although Gordon kept occasional diaries throughout his life, there is no set of regularly kept diaries. The letters to his family (mostly to his mother) are therefore particularly useful since, as a detailed chronological account of his life, they are in effect a diary. Gordon frequently discusses his official work in the letters; family affairs, including the estate of C.W. Gordon and royalties from his works, are of course a main theme in these letters. The family correspondence to King Gordon includes an extensive run of letters from C.W. Gordon, n.d., 1908-1936. The letters from Helen (King) Gordon occasionally refer to her work in the Presbyterian Women's Missionary Society (she served as provincial president for Manitoba prior to 1925).

C.W. Gordon (Ralph Connor), n.d., 1897-1988. 27cm (volumes 91 to 92).

Includes correspondence; some writings by C.W. Gordon; obituaries, tributes, and articles referring to

him; files on his posthumously published autobiography Postscript to Adventure, including correspondence, a contract, reviews, and a draft of King Gordon's introduction; information on his estate; files on re-issues of his books; and a transcription of a CBC broadcast about him including extended interviews with several family members.

Other Family Papers, n.d., 1834-1856, 1899-1983. 13cm (volume 93).

Correspondence not involving King Gordon; sermon book, 1834-1856, of an ancestor, the Reverend James Robertson of Derby, Vermont (1834-1836), and pastor of the Old Congregational Church, Sherbrooke, Lower Canada (1836-c.1861); letters from Helen King to a friend, 1899; genealogy; and other material.
