INTRODUCTION

The arrangement of the series in the fonds closely follows the original arrangement of this material. File titles within the series, have, whenever possible, reflected the subject of the particular file, followed by a description of the type of material in the file. Correspondence from Skelton to his wife form a particularly important part of this fonds. While parts of the correspondence are of a personal nature, much of it is related to Dr. Skelton's professional activities. The donor has provided a detailed list of the contents of some of the files, which has been placed at the beginning of the collection in volume 1, file 1.

The **ACADEMIC, TEACHING, IMPERIAL CONFERENCE OF 1923**, and **EXTERNAL AFFAIRS** series all document Dr. Skelton's activities while he was a student, a professor, and Under-Secretary for External Affairs. There is some overlap between these series because Dr. Skelton began to teach while he was still finishing his Doctorate, and his interest and participation in the External Affairs department began before he gave up his teaching position. While the files in these series have been arranged chronologically, an attempt has been made wherever possible to list the subject of the material on the file. Where there are many subjects in a file, the file has been named according to the type of material in it, ie. correspondence, notes, memos, etc.

The **LAURIER** series contains material relating to the publication of Dr. Skelton's biography, The Life and Times of Sir Wilfrid Laurier. A few memos and criticisms of an earlier book, The Day of Sir Wilfrid Laurier are at the beginning of the series. This series has been arranged into subseries by type of material and alphabetically by subject. Within the subseries, the material is organized chronologically or numerically. For example, the correspondence relating to the publication of the book is organized chronologically. The drafts of both the English and French versions of the book are arranged according to their chapter numbers. The files which contain research material are dated according to the date that this material was produced rather than the date in which this material was used by Dr. Skelton.

The **ADDRESSES, ARTICLES AND STORIES** series is arranged alphabetically by title. Where articles or addresses are untitled, or where they are less than two pages, they have been gathered together in files named "addresses" and "articles" and inserted into the alphabetical arrangement.

Oversize material from the **LETTERS OF CONDOLENCE** series has been placed in an oversize box and is listed at the end of the finding aid.
