## INTRODUCTION

The W. Arthur Irwin fonds consists of material created and accumulated by Arthur Irwin in the course of his career (1920-1971) and his personal activities (1920-1991).

The Irwin papers have been arranged according to seven series that reflect Arthur Irwin's principal activities and interests. Series titles are: **Mail and Empire and the Globe**, **Maclean's Magazine**, the **National Film Board**, the **Department of External Affairs**, **Victoria Daily Times**, **Personal** and **Memoirs**. The order of these series chronologically parallels the pattern of Irwin's life and career, except for the **Personal** series, which encompasses his entire life. The larger series include sub-series which indicate major activities, interests, or career stages. The material in this fonds has been arranged alphabetically.

The original arrangement of Irwin's papers was retained as much as possible and original file titles were changed or expanded upon only where necessary, to indicate more clearly the contents of files and to maintain order and consistency.

More detail on the arrangement and content of series and subseries is provided in the Inventory Entry, which is included in this finding aid.
