## INTRODUCTION

The Szylling Family papers were presented to the Public Archives of Canada by Mrs. Maria Dobrowolska-Frankowska-Szylling and include her papers, the papers of her first husband, Stefan Frankowski and her second husband, Antoni Szylling.

Antoni Szylling (1884-1971) was born in Ptomiawy near Warsaw. During his military career, in the Polish Army, he attained the rank of Lieutenant General. As a Russian subject Szylling was a member of the Imperial Russian Army during World War I. He fought in the Polish Army against Soviet Russia in the Polish-Bolshevik War in 1920. During the German invasion in September 1939 he commanded the Krakow Army. Like many other Polish officers and soldiers, he was captured and held as a prisoner-of-war at Murnav till 1945. After coming to Canada in 1947, Szylling lived on a farm at Abercorn, not far from Montreal. He was active in the Polish emigré community and he also corresponded with his military colleagues. He wrote an unpublished study of his command: "Moje dowodzenie roku 39-ym".

In 1910, Szylling married Zofia Bajkowska (1887-1944) and they had two sons, Jerzy (1921-1943) and Karol (1925-1959). In 1949, Szylling married Maria Roza, the widow of a former comrade-in-arms, Admiral Stefan Frankowski.

Stefan Frankowski (1887-1940) chose a naval career in his youth and rose to the rank of Rear-Admiral, Commander of the Polish Coastal Defence in Gdynia-Oksynne. He died not long after Poland's defeat in a German prisoner-of-war camp at Silberberg. In 1922 Frankowski married Maria Roza Dobrowolska and they had two children: Stefan and Jolanka.

Maria Roza Dobrowolska was born in 1896 in the Kiev region, of Polish-Scottish parentage. In 1922, she married Stefan Frankowski. She was evacuated from Poland in 1939 and in 1940 moved to Canada, selecting Montreal as her home. In 1947 she was joined there by her mother and in 1949 she remarried, this time to General Antoni Szylling. Mrs. Szylling was active in the Polish community and was a contributor to Polish-language newspapers. She also wrote an unpublished history of her family entitled: "Monografia Klucza Tulinskiego na tle Genealogii Wlascieli". She died in Vancouver on 13 April 1986.

The papers presented by Mrs. Szylling in 1976 and 1977 include the few early documents that survived the

war of both her husbands, some of her personal and family papers from Poland and her brother Alexander Dobrowolski, who was in the Polish Diplomatic Service, and some materials recovered from Poland in the 1960's. Most of the materials date since World War II, the largest part being correspondence, notes and the manuscript of General Szylling. Also of particular interest are the diaries of Maria Roza Szylling recording her experiences during World War I, the reminiscences of her mother, focussing largely on her experiences during World War II and the correspondence of Szylling's friend and colleague, General Kazimierz Sosnkowski. The collection also helps to document the life of the Polish emigrés and immigrants in Canada after World War II.
