He received a commission in the Connaught Rangers serving in North America, 1813-1815. He went with his regiment to Calcutta. Associated with the Canada Company, he emigrated to Canada in 1826, to the Huron tract. His brother Robert Dunlop also emigrated to Canada a few years later. Both served in the Legislature. William Dunlop died in 1848.</p> |
