MG 26 A MACDONALD, Rt. Hon. Sir John Alexander (1815-1891). Prime Minister.

John A. Macdonald was born in Scotland and was raised and educated in Kingston, Upper Canada. He was a lawyer, but during most of his life political duties left him little time for his law practice. He married twice and was survived by his second wife and two children.

He entered provincial politics as a Conservative in 1844, becoming a member of the Executive Council in 1847. Macdonald played a major role in creating the Coalition of 1854 which he moulded into the Liberal-Conservative Party which dominated much of the succeeding half century. He was the central figure in the creation of the Canadian Confederation of 1867. Becoming Canada's first prime minister in 1867, he retained that post until 1873. He was prime minister again from 1878 until his death on 6 June 1891. Besides being prime minister, Macdonald held numerous important cabinet posts. Macdonald was central to many Canadian political developments such as the Northwest Rebellions, the Pacific Scandal, the Canadian Pacific Railway and the National Policy.

The papers of Sir John A. Macdonald were arranged between 1891 and 1917 by Macdonald's former secretary and literary executor Sir Joseph Pope, who placed the papers in the Public Archives at the request of Baroness Macdonald. The papers contain approximately 276,000 pages, most of which concern post-Confederation affairs. Ninety-five percent of the collection has been microfilmed on 202 reels. The microfilm is available in provincial archives.

There are two basic types of finding aids available. Computer indexes exist for volumes 1 to 545, 558 and 569 and are available on microfilm. They consist of nominal (microfilm reels C-4810 to C-4813), subject (C-4813 to C-4815) and chronological indexes (C-4815 to C-4818). Each index consists of approximately 150,000 entries. Bound Finding Aid 104 contains a subject list for volumes 1 to 185, an author list for volumes 186 to 296 and a box list for the rest of the collection. Detailed lists exist for the financial papers, letter books, transcripts and a microfilm conversion list.

Political Papers

Subject Files, 1851-1891. Originals, 9.8 m (volumes 1-185).

This material is arranged in alphabetical order by subject. These subjects range from "Alaska Boundary" to "Wrecking on the Great Lakes". Among the most voluminous subjects are appointments (28 vols.L); railways (23 vols.); Governor Generals' correspondence (17 vols.L); Washington Treaties of 1871 and 1888 (17 vols.); Confederation (9 vols.); federal elections (8 vols.); Fenians (7 vols.); North West Rebellions (7 vols.). The volumes include correspondence, memoranda, maps and pamphlets.

Correspondent Files, 1843-1891. Originals 5.7 m (volumes 186-296).

These consist of letters from approximately one hundred persons with whom there was considerable correspondence. The volumes are arranged alphabetically. Among the most voluminous correspondence is that from Gilbert McMicken (secret service reports, 12 vols.); Sir George Stephen (6 vols.); Sir Alexander Campbell (5 vols.); Hon. Edgar Dewdney (5 vols.); Sir Alexander T. Galt (5 vols.); Lawrence Vankoughnet (5 vols.); Sir David MacPherson (4 vols.); Sir Charles Tupper (4 vols.).

Miscellaneous, 1836-1891. Originals, 2.9 m (volumes 297-335).

Contains mostly correspondence, but also includes memoranda, reports, pamphlets and clippings. Arrangement is subject, and subjects are in rough chronological order. There is a list of subject in each volume.

General Letters, 1832-1891. Originals, 9.3 m (volumes 336-503).

This series contains the residue of Macdonald's correspondence after the above subject and nominal files were organized. They are arranged in chronological order. Only five volumes cover the pre-Confederation period.

Letter books, 1855-1891. Originals, 1.3 m (volumes 504-536).

Letterpress copies of letters written by Macdonald or his secretaries. Each letterbook has a nominal index and a comprehensive index was prepared by Pope for the period 31 March 1864 to 27 May 1891 (volume 536). There are no letters in this series for the period 1 November 1873 to 2 October 1878

Transcripts of letterbooks, 1855-1891, typescript. 3 m (volumes 571-576c).

Transcripts of Letterbooks 1-28a were prepared by the Public Archives Publications Division. There are some gaps, chiefly because letters are illegible. Transferred from Publications in 1972 and 1974.

Personal Papers

Personal Correspondence, 1847-1891. Originals, 10 cm (volumes 537).

Included are letters from Macdonald's son Hugh John, and other relatives; also correspondence respecting such subjects as marriage, honours, membership in the Freemasons and remedies for illnesses.

Legal, 1835-1874. Originals, 81 cm (volumes 538-545).

There is correspondence with partners and others respecting legal practice along with dockets of legal cases.

Miscellaneous, 1827-1891. Originals, 43 cm (volumes 546-550)

The series contains documents relating to volume 537 such as wills, commissions, marriage certificates, poems and prescriptions. There are notebooks containing lists of appointments, election supporters, daily memoranda and school problems. Invitations for 1884-1890 are also available.

Personal Finances, 1833-1891. Originals, 71 cm (volumes 551-557).

Included are accounts, receipts, promissory notes, bank books, tax receipts and insurance policies. The accounts and receipts have been arranged in subject files such as books, clothing, real estate, medical, clubs, etc. A detailed index is available.

Family Papers

Baroness Macdonald, 1845-1910. Originals, 81 cm (volumes 558-567).

There is general correspondence for 1845, 1884-1910 and her diary describing the Macdonald' daily life and political events of the time for 1867-1872, 1875 and 1883 (vol. 559A). The diary is also available on microfilm reel C-1447. An 1895 letter describes Lady Macdonald's life in an Italian villa. There are addresses and letters of sympathy following Macdonald's death in 1891.

Baroness Macdonald Finances, 1867-1910. Originals, 17 cm (volumes 567-568).

Documents relating to Lady Macdonald's marriage settlement, will and estate are available. Household accounts, bank books, cancelled cheques and stubs are in the same series. A Sir John A. Macdonald account book 1879-1881 is also present.

Family Correspondence, 1852-1889. Originals, 8 cm (volume 569).

There is correspondence to Macdonald's mother, sister Louisa and daughter. Other correspondence relates to Margaret Green (a sister-in-law), Anna Macpherson (a cousin) and Minnie Macdonnell (an intimate family friend). A few genealogical notes are also available.

Additional papers, 1852-1969. Originals, photocopies and typescripts. 2.5 cm (volumes 570, 577 and 578).

Several items have been added to the Macdonald Papers from other sources. A list of these items is included in the Bound Finding Aid as Appendix F.

Macdonald Letter Transcripts, originals, 1964-1971; photocopies, 1836-1891; typescripts 1836-1891. 3 m (volumes 579-593).

Present are transcripts and xerox copies of Macdonald letters collected for volumes 1 and 2 of the book "The Papers of the Prime Ministers, Sir John A. Macdonald, 1836-1866", and a proposed volume 3. Files relating to the publications of the books are also available. Transferred from the Public Archives Publications Divisions en 1976.

MG 26 A MACDONALD, Le Très Honourable Sir John Alexander (1815-1891).
Premier Ministre.

Naif d'Écosse, Josh Alexander Macdonald grandit et étudia à Kingston, dans le Haut-Canada. Il fit carrière comme avocat, mais ses nombreuses occupations politiques lui laissèrent peu de temps pour exercer sa profession. Il se maria deux fois. Sa seconde épouse et ses deux enfants lui survécurent.

Il débuta dans la politique provinciale comme député conservateur en 1844 et devint ministre en 1847. Macdonald joua un rôle primordial en formant la Grande Coalition de 1854, laquelle devint par ses soins le Parti libéral-conservateur qui domina le demi-siècle suivant. Il fut le personnage central dans la création de la Confédération Canadienne. Macdonald devint le premier ministre en 1867 et demeura dans ce poste jusqu'en 1873. Il fut premier ministre encore une fois de 1878 jusqu'à sa mort, le 6 juin 1891. En plus d'être premier ministre, Macdonald remplit plusieurs postes importants au sein du cabinet. Macdonald joua un rôle important au cours des rébellions du Nord-Ouest, du scandale du Pacifique, de la création du chemin de fer du Canadien Pacifique et de l'établissement de la politique nationale.

Les papiers de sir John A. Macdonald furent classés entre 1891 et 1917 par un ancien secrétaire et exécutif littéraire, sir Joseph Pope, à la demande de la baronne Macdonald qui souhaitait que les papiers fussent déposés aux Archives publiques. L'ensemble des papiers comprend 276,000 pages, la plupart se rapportant à la période postérieure à la Confédération. Quatre-vingt-quinze pour cent de la collection est disponible sur 202 bobines de microfilm. Les microfilms sont disponibles aux archives provinciales.

Les instruments de recherche existent sous deux formes. Les index d'ordinateur existent pour les volumes 1 à 545, 558 et 569 et sont disponibles sur microfilm. Ces index sont constitués de listes nominatives (bobines C-4810 à C-4813), par sujets (C-4813 à C-4815) et de listes chronologiques (C-4815 à C-4818). Chaque index contient environ 150,000 données. L'instrument de recherche relié no 104 donne une liste des sujets des volumes 1 à 185, une liste des auteurs des volumes 186 à 296 et une liste topographique du contenu pour le reste de la collection. Il y a des listes détaillées pour les papiers financiers, les copies de lettres, les transcriptions et une table de conversion de microfilm.

Lettres à Macdonald classées selon l'ordre alphabétique des sujets. Parmi les sujets les plus importants, on note les nominations (28 vols.); les chemins de fer (23 vols.); les traités de Washington de 1871 et 1888 (17 vols.); la Confédération (9 vols.); les élections fédérales (8 vols.); les Fénians (7 vols.); la Rébellion du Nord-Ouest (7 vols.). Ces volumes comprennent de la correspondance, des mémoires, des cartes et des brochures.

Classés par correspondants, 1843-1891. Originaux 5.7 m (volumes 186-296).

Cette série comprend les lettres d'une centaine de personnes avec lesquelles il a échangé une correspondance considérable. Les volumes sont classés en ordre alphabétique. Parmi la plus volumineuse correspondance, on trouve celle de Gilbert McMicken (rapports du service secret, 12 vols.); sir George Stephen (6 vols.); sir Alexander Campbell (5 vols.); l'honorable Edgar Dewdney (5 vols.); Alexander T. Divers, 1836-1891. Originaux, 2.9 m (volumes 297-335).

Composés surtout de correspondance, ces documents comprennent aussi des mémoires, des rapports, des brochures et des coupures de presse. Le classement est par sujet et, à l'intérieur des sujets, en ordre chronologique. Liste des sujets dans chaque volume.

Correspondance générale, 1832-1891. Originaux, 9.3 m (volumes 336-503).

Ces documents sont composés du reste des lettres envoyées à Macdonald après que fut opérée la sélection pour le sujet précédent et pour les lettres classées par correspondant. Ils sont classés en ordre chronologique. Seulement cinq volumes couvrent la période antérieure à la Confédération.

Copies de lettres, 1855-1891. Originaux, 1.3 m (volumes 504-536).

Copies de lettres écrites par Macdonald ou par ses secrétaires. Chaque copie de lettre comporte un index nominatif; un index général a été préparé par Pope pour la période du 31 mars 1864 au 27 mai 1891 (volume 536). Il n'y a pas de lettres dans cette série pour la période du 1^{er} novembre 1873 au 2 octobre 1878.

Transcriptions de livres de copies de lettres, 1855-1891; dactylographiées, 1.8 m (volumes 571-576c).

Transcriptions des livres de copies de lettres 1-28a effectuées par la Division des publications des Archives publiques. On y trouve des lacunes, qui sont principalement attribuables à l'illisibilité de certaines lettres. Transférées de la Division des publications en 1972 et 1974.

Correspondance juridique, 1835-1874. Originaux, 81 cm (volumes 538-545).

Correspondance avec des associés et d'autres personnes au sujet de la pratique du droit; on y trouve aussi des registres de causes.

Divers, 1827-1891. Originaux, 43 cm (9 volumes 546-550).

Testament, commissions, certificats de mariage, poèmes, prescriptions et autres pièces principalement rattachées à la correspondance personnelle dans le volume 537. Cahiers de notes avec des listes de nominations et de partisans aux élections, mémoires quotidiens et problèmes scolaires. Il y a des invitations 1884 à 1890.

Finances personnelles, 1833-1891. Originaux, 71 cm (volumes 551-557).

Comptes et reçus, billets à ordre, livrets de banque, quittances de taxes et polices d'assurance. Les comptes et les reçus ont été classés dans des dossiers par sujets tels livres, habillement, biens immobiliers, frais médicaux, clubs, etc.
