#### DESCRIPTION OF THE FONDS

**Peter Mann fonds** (accrual files). 1872-1998, predominant 1957-1986. 22 cm of textual records, 3 cm of philatelic records, 4 drawings, 2 photographs, 4 medals, 2 plaques, 4 audio reels.

#### Biographical sketch

Peter McGeary Mann was born in London (Ontario). He served in the Canadian Army at the end of the Second World War. When he returned to Canada, he studied in zoology at the University of Western Ontario from which he completed graduate degrees. He lives in Guelph (Ontario).

He was first interested in philately in 1936 for a short period of time. He came back to the hobby again nealy 25 years after. He has been involved in many philatelic activities and organizations. He joined the Guelph Stamp Club in 1957 where he held many executive positions. He was the Royal Philatelic Society of Canada chapter representative and the Grand River Philatelic Association delegate. He became director, secretary-tresurer and president of the latter association. In 1969, he became the first editor of its newsletter The Grand News. Since 1964 he was the editor of the Guelph Stamp Club newsletter.

He was also a member of the Royal Philatelic Society of Canada and served as a director for several years. He retired in 1987. He is now a life member. With his experience in editing, publishing and distributing he became editor of The Canadian Philatelist until 1982. Under the leadership of Peter Mann, the magazine won several international prizes in philatelic literature.

In 1986, he acted as Canadian Commissioner for the international philatelic exhibition in Stockolm. He does collect stamps but he prefers attractive ones mainly from British Commonwealth countries. He likes to build model airplanes (he is the archivist for the National Association for Model Airplanes) and to collect classical and jazz music CDs

#### Scope and content

The fonds consists of records related to Peter Mann and Frank W. Campbell's philatelic activities.

Personal documents of Peter Mann's activities include correspondence with Quarterman Publications, Inc. and Frank W. Campbell. Also included is the Guelph Stamp Club Newletter from 1957 to 1959, records on Guelph postal history, Grand River Valley Philatelic Association, papers on philately of which "Petroleum in Philately" published in Imperial Oil Review, vol. 34, no. 2 around 1951 and the Royal Philatelic Society of Canada by-laws. Some files contain postal stationery items, postal covers, postcards, postage stamps and labels.

The fonds documents the participation of Peter Mann to some philatelic exhibitions: Hintonpex from 1977 to 1979, Rocpex Taipei'78 and Philaserdica'79. These files includes

one postcard, panes of labels and photographs.

The fonds contains sound recording interviews (4 audio reels) recorded from 1971 to 1975 at philatelic meetings and philatelic exhibitions such as Kitchener-Waterloo Philatelic Society, Grand River Valley Philatelic association, Guelphpex'72, Guelphpex'73, Stampex in Toronto in 1973 and Royal Oak in Guelph in 1973 and Michigan in 1974. Among introducing speakers and guest speakers: Peter Mann, Fred Jarrett, Pete Wiedemann, J.W. Holmes, S.W. Shelton and Frank W. Campbell. The latter comments in 1975 the typewritten copy of the Quartermann edition of the Canadian Postal History book.

The fonds contains several medals and plaques awarded to Peter Mann as editor of The Canadian Philatelist and for his contribution to philately. These awards were received at Capex'78, Rocpex Taipei'78, Philaserdica'79 and Espamer'81.

Finally, the fonds documents philatelic activities of Frank W. Campbell. It includes articles and notes written by Campbell, correspondence (including 6 postal covers from 1872 to 1973), the 1958 and 1875 versions of his Canadian Postal history.

#### Immediate source of acquisition

Records were given by Peter Mann to Library and Archives Canada on October 8, 2002 and on June 4, 2003.
