He was elected Governor of the Hudson's Bay Company in 1889 and in 1896 he became Canadian High Commissioner to Great Britain. In 1897 he was raised to the peerage as Baron Strathcona and in 1896 he became Canadian High Commissioner to Great Britain. imprisoned at Fort Garry by Louis Riel.
