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BELL, CHARLES NAPIER (1854-1936)

He became interested in western and local history and served for many years as president of the Historical and Scientific Society of Charles Napier Bell (1854-1936) went to the Red River district with the Wolseley expedition in 1870 and remained at Winnipeg. Manitoba. He was the author of several historical works.

The finding aid provides a list of the items, in chronological order.
