ZOLF, Larry Collection (1934- ).

Larry Zolf was born in Winnipeg, obtained a B.A. at the University of Manitoba in 1956, and was a student in the law programme at Osgoode Hall in 1957, and later the M.A. history programme at the University of Toronto. In 1959 he worked for the Ontario Archives, and in 1960 joined the labour movement as Research Secretary for the Toronto Health Organizing Committee. In 1963 he joined the C.B.C. as a contributor to the programme, "This Hour has Seven Days", and has since worked for the network as producer, director, and writer. He is the author of Dance of the Dialectic and a contributor to numerous publications.

Arthur Roebuck (1878-1971) was a candidate for the Ontario Legislature in 1911 and 1914 and for the House of Commons in 1917. He was elected to the Ontario Legislature in 1934 and served as Attorney-General (1934-1937), Minister of Labour (1934-1935) and was also a member of the Ontario Electric Power Commission (1934-1937). He resigned his portfolios and his seat in 1937 and was re-elected to the Legislature in the same year. He was elected to the House of Commons in 1940 and was summoned to the Senate in 1945.

The Larry Zolf Collection contains two sets of papers. The first set contains the notes and interviews made by Larry Zolf in researching his M.A. thesis. The second set contains original documents given by Arthur Roebuck to Larry Zolf, for the purpose of researching his thesis. The first set remain in the order Zolf established; the second set has been re-organized to approximate Arthur Roebuck's original order. The Collection was presented to the Archives in 1974 by Larry Zolf of Toronto.
