UPPER CANADA BIBLE SOCIETY: JOHN GEORGE HODGINS COLLECTION

(MG 17 F 3)

INTRODUCTION

The first Bible Society in Canada was formed at Quebec in 1804, the year in which the British and Foreign Bible Society itself, "the Parent Society", was founded by the Clapham group in London Tavern. In Upper Canada "The Bible and Prayer Book Society" appeared at York in 1817 and promptly disappeared three years later. A new organization was organized in 1828, becoming in 1839, the Upper Canada Bible Society.

The thirty years from 1854 to 1884 have been called "The Years of Progress".* In 1863 the Upper Canada Bible Society sent one of its Travelling Agents, the Rev. Lachlin Taylor via Panama to British Columbia, where he founded the British Columbia Bible Society. It folded shortly after but was revived in 1871 in association with the U.C.B.S. The Manitoba Bible Society was founded the following year, again in association with Toronto, and in 1883 a Branch was formed at Fort Simpson on the Mackenzie River. In 1870 the Society began issuing the Bible Society Recorder, a bi-monthly, followed later by the Monthly Reporter and Gleanings for the Young. By 1869 it had 253 Branches, or 359 including London and Kingston with their sub-branches. In this entire thirty year period the U.C.B.S. distributed over 1,000,000 Bibles and Testaments.

Such gains, however, were inevitably attended by growth pains. At the very moment Toronto was sending its agents to the Pacific and the Mackenzie, the eastern and western wings in Ontario challenged its metropolitan control. In 1873 the Kingston Auxiliary seceded amid considerable acrimony. While it formed the nucleus of a small Central Bible Society most of its branches remained in the U.C.B.S., and Kingston itself returned to the fold in 1885. Six years previous, however, the London Auxiliary had left under similar circumstances. It had been formed as a compromise in 1864, London wishing to be an auxiliary of the Parent Society, but having become instead an "Auxiliary

to the Upper Canada Bible Society". In 1879, however, it formed the Western Ontario Bible Society and considerable rivalry between the two soon followed.

In 1903 the Canadian Bible Society was formed, the U.C.B.S. being one of the founding Auxiliaries.

John George Hodgins (1821-1912) was born in Dublin Ireland, and emigrated to Canada in 1833. He was educated at Upper Canada Academy, Victoria College and the University of Toronto (LL. D, 1870). In 1855 he became deputy superintendent of education under Egerton Ryerson, and from 1876-1889 held the post of deputy minister of education in Ontario. He was librarian and historiographer to the department from 1890 to his death. His most notable work was the <u>Documentary History of Education in Upper Canada</u> (28 vols., 1894-1910). Hodgins was one of the founders of the Royal Canadian Humane Society and its honorary secretary; honorary secretary of the International Congress of Educators (New Orleans); a fellow of the Academy of Sciences (New Orleans); F.R.G.S.; recipient of the Palm Leaf (French) and of the Confederation Medal.

As a member of the Toronto social elite, Hodgins was, at various times, Vice-President of the Toronto Humane Society, President of the Prisoners' Aid Society and of the Irish Protestant Benevolent Association, lieutenant and later captain in the Queen's Own Rifles, which he helped form, secretary of Synod of the Anglican Diocese of Toronto and secretary and honorary secretary of the Upper Canada Bible Society from 1860-1886.

The position of honorary secretary was a key one in the structure of the Society, and the letters and memoranda written to Hodgins throw some light on the inner workings of the Society during those thirty years of expansion and crisis. In 1871 a permanent secretary had to be appointed due to the great increase of work. During the Kingston and London crises the secretaries, Hodgins among them, seem to have directed the Society's defense and counter-attacks.

While the Hodgins papers are interesting for what they reveal of the inner workings of the Society, they are also very frustrating because largely composed of short notes, memoranda, agendas, etc. which hint at what is happening more than they explain or describe it. They are, therefore, of greatly increased value if used in conjunction with the annual reports and the official papers of the Canadian Bible Society in MG 17 F 1.

The papers, which were acquired in 1973, arrived at the Public Archives in thirteen bound volumes, marked II to XIV each containing published reports and periodicals most often mixed with manuscript letters and memoranda. As the collection was generally chronological, it was decided to maintain the original order rather than to attempt to place the material in strictly chronological sequence. It was also felt that the location of the numerous blank froms which Hodgins seems to have kept as samples probably revealed the approximate date of their use. The volumes, however, were unbound, and renumbered from I-XIII, the manuscripts and duplicate publications numbered and placed in file folders, and the rest of the publications sent to the Public Archives Library. The finding aid indicates what was transferred and what retained.

Finding Aid 675 is a descriptive list of the documents, by volume, as they appear in the collection, with a nominal index to the finding aid. In effect, however, it is also a nominal index to the collection as all names in the documents were included in the description of them. Note that the location numbers are <u>document</u> numbers and not page numbers. Finally, MSS in the last column indicates the document is with the rest of the collection in the Manuscript Division, while LIB indicates that it was transferred to the Public Archives Library.
