MCDONALD, John Haskell (1913-1970). Lawyer.

John H. McDonald graduated from McGill University and was admitted to the Quebec Bar in 1939. he worked with the Foreign Exchange Board in 1940. After serving with the Royal Canadian Navy from 1941 to 1944, he was appointed Executive Assistant to the Hon. Brooke Claxton, Minister of National Health and Welfare in 1945, and was a member of the Canadian Delegation to the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations in 1946. In 1947, he was admitted to the Ontario Bar. In 1949 and 1953 was the unsuccessful Liberal candidate in Carleton constituency, running against George Drew. McDonald provided legal advice on a number of matters of interest, such as trading stamps, the St. Lawrence Seaway, tariff and patent disputes, immigration policy, bilingualism, and plans for the National Capital.

Presented in 1967 by J.H. McDonald of Toronto, Ont. and in 1971 by Mrs. J.H. McDonald.
