G.R.McGregor was born in Montreal in 1901, was educated at McGill and joined the Engineering Department of Bell Canada in 1923. He began flying in 1933 and three times won the Webster Trophy as Canada's best amateur pilot. In 1939 he went on active service with the R.C.A.F., and served successively commander of the Second Canadian Fighter Squadron (1941), Director of Air Staff of R.C.A.F. Headquarters, Europe (1941-42) commander of Canadian Wing in the Aleutian campaign (1942-43), commander of Patricia Bay Air Force Base, B.C. (1943-44) and commander of a wing of the Second Tactical Air Force in France and Holland (1944-45). He was discharged with the rank of Group Captain.

McGregor joined Trans Canada Air Lines (Air Canada) in 1945, serving as General Traffic Manager, 1946-48, and as President, 1948-1968. At the time of his death in 1971 he was Chairman of Orenda Ltd. and a director of Hawker Siddeley Canada Ltd.

The first portion of the papers (volumes 1-3) were transferred in 1977 from the Canadian War Museum except for two pages which were presented by Miss E. Buchanan also in 1977. The remainder of the papers (volumes 4-29) were transferred to the Archives by Miss E. Buchanan in 1980 and 1982.

Photographs were transferred to the National Photography Collection, maps to the National Map Collection and printed material to the PAC Library.

Finding Aid No. 681 is a file list with descriptive notes. An attempt was made to retain the original filing system but where necessary items have been added to the existing order.

Personal material, 1933-1971. 4 cm (volume 1).

Biographical material, identity cards, financial documents and pilot's licenses, together with correspondence concerning McGregor's awards, finances and other aspects of his personal life. Most of the files contain partial lists of contents.

Correspondence, 1937-1971. 6 cm (volume 1).

Correspondence mostly relating to McGregor's R.C.A.F. career. Included are files from McGregor's various commands in World War II, and a post-war file on matters concerning the R.C.A.F. Arranged chronologically.

Memoranda, service manuals and data, booklets and notes relating to the R.C.A.F., and one file on a Kingston to Moose Jaw flight made by McGregor in 1937.
