## INTRODUCTION

Included in this series are Ordinances of the Military Governors of the District of Montreal, 1760-1764, and of the Civil Governor of Quebec, 1764-1792. The listing is not definitive: the most complete and reliable listing of the ordinances should be found in the Minute Books of the Legislative Council of Quebec, 1764-1792 (RG 1, E 1, volumes 105-110). Proposed ordinances can be found in this series and in RG 14, A 1. Most ordinances were printed in the Quebec Gazette and annual summaries were produced by the King's Printer (eg. vol. 1A here). The Ordinances of the Special Council, 1838, were transferred in 1975 to RG 14, A 6 and integrated with other ordinances of that body for 1838-1841

From about 1780, draft minutes of Council, notes of votes taken on amendments, opinions and reports on proposals, correspondence and petitions relating to the preparation and passage of ordinances are included with various copies of the text for each. The presence of such material has not been specifically mentioned in the finding aid but may be presumed from the quantity noted. Further such records covering the period 1775-1791 are also found in RG 14, A 1, volumes 1-7.

Most of the ordinances passed in the period 1764-1791 were printed in full in the Report of the Public Archives of Canada, 1913, Appendix E and 1914-1915, Appendix C. This has been noted in the fourth column of the finding aid. The first column indicates the existence of draft and fair copies and supporting material in RG 4, B 6, volumes 5-23; the second,, copies entered in registers, volumes 1-4; and the third, copies engrossed on parchment, volumes 5-23. On occasion, copies were engrossed on paper and sealed; these are noted in the first column by the term "wax seal". Titles are copied according to the style of the original, including many variations in spelling.
