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INTRODUCTION

Finding aid #198 describes both the papers of William Morris (MG 24 B 8) and the papers of Alexander Morris (MG 27 I C8). This was necessitated because the William and Alexander Morris correspondence at Queen's University from which this microfilm copy was taken is contained in the same unit and was microfilmed as a unit (microfilm reels M67 and M68). Microfilm reels M69-M70 are Alexander Morris papers (MG 27 I C8) filmed from originals at the Manitoba Archives.

The finding aid consists of a listing of all the items contained on microfilm reels M67 and M68, and to portions only of reels M69 and M70. The Shelf-List which follows indicates to which portions of reels M69 and M70 there is a finding aid.

There is no finding aid other than the inventory entry to the hard-copy (originals or photostat) of either the William Morris or the Alexander Morris papers.

MG 24 MORRIS, William (1786-1858). Politician. B 8

William Morris (1786-1858) was elected to the Legislative Assembly of Upper Canada as a member for Lanark in 1820 and continued to represent Lanark until 1836. From 1836 to 1841 he served on the Legislative Council of Upper Canada and in 1841 he was appointed a Legislative Councillor for Canada. In 1844 he became Receiver-General in the Draper administration where he served until 1846 and from 1846 to 1848 he was President of the Executive Council. He was also the first chairman of Queen's University Board of Trustees, Kingston. Finding Aid No. 918 describes both the papers of William Morris here which were copied from the originals at Queens University and those of Alexander Morris in MG 27 I C 8. It consists of a chronological list of correspondents and appears also at the beginning of reel M-67.

Papers relating chiefly to political subjects, the Presbyterian Church, clergy reserves, and Queen's University. Copied from originals at Queen's University, Kingston. The papers of Alexander Morris which form part of the original collection are described in MG 27 I C 8. Acquired in 1950.

Hon. Alexander Morris (1826-1889) was a Conservative Member of the Canada Legislative Assembly, 1861-1867, of the House of Commons, 1867-1872 (Minister of Inland Revenue, 1869-1872), Chief of the Court of Queen's Bench, Manitoba, July - December 1872, Lieutenant-Governor of Manitoba, 2 December 1872 - 1 December 1877, and ex-officio Lieutenant-Governor of the Northwest Territories, 2 December 1872 - 6 October 1876, and Member of the Ontario Legislative Assembly, 1878-1886.

Microfilm copies of Alexander Morris Papers have been obtained from two sources: Queen's University has papers of Morris and of his father, Hon. William Morris (1786-1858). These were filmed by the Public Archives in 1950. The Archives of Manitoba has papers of Alexander Morris relating to his term of office as Lieutenant-Governor, which were also microfilmed by the Public Archives in 1951.

This correspondence is on the same microfilm reels as the correspondence of William Morris. The Alexander Morris correspondence is on pages 587-590 and 617-989 (reel M68).
