CITY OF TORONTO AND LAKE HURON RAILWAY COMPANY

<u> 1845 - 1853</u>

The City of Toronto and Lake Huron Railway Company was incorporated in Upper Canada in 1836. The charter called for the construction of a railroad linking Toronto with Goderich. Very little was done until 1845 when a London Branch of the Company was set up. The London Board of Directors took over the management of financial affairs. The shares of the Company were offered to subscribers, and the whole capital of £ 500,000 (save 2,000 shares reserved for Canada) was taken up within a short time.

Difficulties arose between the London and the Toronto Boards which in 1849 resulted in the re-organization of the Toronto Board. The new company became known as the Toronto, Simcoe and Huron Railway Company, and four years later the London Branch was dissolved.

In 1855 a railroad line was constructed from Toronto to Collingwood. Another series of reorganizations took place in 1888 resulting in the absorption of the railroad into the Grand Trunk System.
