

Teillet Papers Finding Aid.

The Honourable Roger Teillet was born in St. Vital, Manitoba, 21 August 1912. He was educated at St. Vital and nearby St. Boniface schools and at St. Boniface College. From 1935 to 1940 he was with a life assurance and annuity company. In May 1940, he married the former Jeanne Boux of St. Boniface.

Mr. Teillet enlisted in the RCMP in October 1940 and upon completion of his aircrew training was commissioned as an observer. He proceeded overseas in September 1941 and was attached to Bomber Command. In August 1942 he was shot down and became a prisoner of war until May 1945. While a P.O.W. he studied German and Spanish.

Upon his return to Canada and release from the RCMP with the rank of flight-lieutenant, he returned to the insurance business, and in 1950 he purchased his own agency.

Mr. Teillet was a member of the Manitoba Legislative Assembly from 1953 to 1959. He was elected to the House of Commons in 1962, representing St. Boniface. He was appointed Minister of Veterans' Affairs on 22 April 1963. From 1965 to 1968 he alone represented the prairie provinces in the Cabinet. Prior to the election of 1968 Mr. Teillet failed in his bid for re-nomination in St. Boniface. Later that year he was appointed as a Commissioner with the Canadian Pension Commission.

Most of the Teillet Papers relate to Mr. Teillet's activities as an M.P. and Minister of Veterans' Affairs. There is considerable material on Manitoba politics and the affairs of the federal and provincial Liberal parties in the Western Provinces, particularly in Manitoba. Samples of the patronage passing through Mr. Teillet's office have also been retained.

The Teillet Papers were presented to the Archives in 1968 by the Hon. Roger Teillet. Their original extent was approximately 50 feet. A large number of books were separated from the main body of the papers and were transferred to the PAC Library. Many routine files and much duplicate material was destroyed. (c. 20 feet) In the final arrangement of the papers an attempt was made to retain or recreate, as much as possible and convenient, the original organization of the unit.
