J. Carlisle Hanson (1920-) was born in New Brunswick and received his early education in that province. He received his M.A. at McGill on a Bronfman Fellowship in 1947 and studied law and economics in 1947-48 at the London School of Economics, on a Beaverbrook Overseas Scholarship. He was called to the bar in 1951 and practised law till 1953 when he joined the Federal Civil Service. In 1957 he was appointed Private Secretary and Executive Assistant to the Minister of Veterans Affairs. He resigned in 1959 and resumed his law practice although he remained active in Conservative party circles.

The finding Aid No. 706 is a file list.

The papers contain correspondence and printed matter relating to J.C. Hanson's affiliation with European Socialist and C.C.F. circles in the 1940's, his activities in various positions in Ottawa in the 1950's, and his active role in the Progressive Conservative Party on the national level during the Diefenbaker years. Included are reports on the general election in 1958 and detailed election material for Russell constituency in 1958 and 1959. Also included are Hanson-Beaverbrook correspondence relating largely to Beaverbrook Scholarships for the 1940's and 1950's, and land papers of Gloucester Township, Carleton County for 1846, 1847, 1871, and 1960. Also included is a copy of The Hanson Documents, selected papers dealing with the forebears and descendants of John Hanson of Maryland and John Hanson of New England and New Brunswick.
