Correspondence of Louisiana officials addressed to the Minister.

1758-59: Kerlerec, governor, relates the arrival of Rochemore and of fresh troops. Relations with Indian tribes; financial affairs; arrival of supply and merchant vessels: l'Opale, la Fortune, le Patriote, le Bizarre. Ships wrecked along the Gulf Coast during storms. Letters of credit issued against the colony. Colonial administration and the government of the Indian population. Public works; building projects. Quarrel opposing Kerlerec and Rochemore. Disorder at Mobile; the affair Belle-Isle. Plans to establish a floating station at the mouth of the Mississippi. Rochemore reports on local usages in regard to honors and protocol. Explanations regarding the Jamaican ship arrived at New Orleans under a flag of truce. Rochemore's opinions on relations with Indian tribes. 169 clichés)

1768: Aubry exposes the situation created by the refusal of French troops to serve under the Spanish flag. Report on the rebellion of the population of New Orleans, 29 October 1768, against the cession of Louisiana to Spain. The King's instructions to Jean Jacques d'Abbadie for the transfer of sovereignty to Spain. 36 clichés.

An 12: Orders issued by Laussat; broadsides announcing policy decisions; Laussat's reports on the transfer of Louisiana from Spain to France, then to the United States. 15 clichés.
