Edward MacDonnel (1766-1812) married Ann Johnson (1774-1848), daughter of Sir John Johnson; their son, Charles MacDonnell (f1.1825-60) married Ann Turner, daughter of John Turner (d.1835), court jeweller to William IV. Charles MacDonnell's daughter, Katherine Sophia MacDonnell (1836-1911) married her cousin Archibald Kennedy Johnson (1839-73); their son Sir Edward Gordon Johnson (1867-1957) was the 5th baronet. Another daughter, Frances MacDonnell (1834-1911), married William Wilson (1835-89), sometime Law Clerk of the House of Commons; their daughter, Mary Frances (Mollie) Wilson, married Gustav Adolph Kuhring (1857-1923). All of these family connections are reflected in the papers.
