Born in London, England, Alexander Tilloch Galt came to Canada in 1830 and in 1835 entered the service of the British American Land Company. He became Commissioner of the company and a promoter and important stockholder in the St. Lawrence and Atlantic Railroad and the Grand Trunk Railway.

Galt represented Sherbrooke County, 1849-1850, 1853-1872, first in the Legislative Assembly of Canada, then in the House of Commons. He was Inspector General, 1858-1862, Minister of Finance, 1864-1865, 1867, and Minister of Agriculture, 1865-1866. He was a member of the Halifax Fishery Commission, 1877, and was the first Canadian High Commissioner to the United Kingdom, 1880-1883.

The bulk of the Sir Alexander Tilloch Galt Papers (vols. 1-8) were presented in 1951 by his daughter, Miss Muriel Galt; the letterbooks (vol. 10) were acquired in 1972 from Dr. H.B. Timothy; the items in Vol. 9 were presented in 1960 by Mrs. T.B. Heney, in 1964 by Mrs. J.B. Heney and in 1966 by Mr. Elliott Burnford; vols. 5a and 5b were transferred in 1969 from the National Museum of Man.

The finding aid No. 76 contains a descriptive list of the correspondence (vols. 1-4, 7-8), arranged alphabetically by correspondent; a subject index of the correspondence arranged alphabetically; and a list of the memoranda, reports and other items (vols. 5-6, 9).

Correspondence, 1858-1891. Originals, 20 cm (Vols. 1-4).

The principal subjects are government finances, 1858-1862, especially relations with George Carr Glyn and Thomas Baring, the London financial agents for the Province of Canada; Confederation and the office of High Commissioner. There are only five letters to Galt after 1881. Of historical importance is the considerable correspondence with his wife, Elizabeth Tilloch. Arranged chronologically.

Letterbooks, 1859-1866, 1883-1886. Originals, 5 cm (Vol. 10).

Letterbooks containing Galt's outgoing correspondence from 10 February 1859 to August 1866, pages 1-192 (with a gap between 19 May 1862 and 10 February 1865 and the following pages missing: 61-64, 91-95, 99-101, 178-179, 185) and from January 1883 to April 1886 (several pages have been torn out and are missing). Arranged chronologically.

Memoranda and Reports, 1851-1891. Originals, 3 cm (Vol. 5).

The principal subjects are Confederation, Imperial trade and reciprocity.
