MACPHAIL, Agnes Campbell (1890-1954). Teacher and Member of Parliament.

Originals, 1921-1954. 1.02 m. Finding Aid No. 107.

Agnes Campbell Macphail (1890-1954), a teacher, was a United Farmers of Ontario Member of Parliament, 1921-1940, and a C.C.F. Member of the Ontario Legislative Assembly, 1943-1951. A spokesman for Canadian farmers and Canadian women, she was particularly interested in co-operatives, penal reform, monetary reform, rural education and public health.

The Macphail Papers were presented by the executors of her estate through Mr. E.B. Joliffe in 1955.

Finding Aid No. 107 comprises a descriptive list of the contents of each volume and a nominal index to correspondents.

General correspondence, 1920-1945. Originals, 20 cm (volumes 1-2).

In chronological order. Only a few letters fall within the period 1920-1929, but the remainder is evenly distributed from 1930 to 1945.

Subject files, 1930-1945. Originals, 30 cm (volumes 3-5).

Memoranda, clippings, pamphlets and notes in approximately 30 subject files. List.

Letters to the press, 1933-1939. Originals, 5 cm (volume 6).

Manuscript of letters written by Macphail for publication in newspapers, particularly weekly reports to her constituents. In chronological order.

Newspaper clippings; 1921-1945. Originals, 15 cm (volumes 6-7).

Chiefly references to Macphail. In chronological order.

Speeches. Originals, 30 cm (volumes 8-10).

Manuscript and notes for speeches. Most are undated. Arranged by subject.

Miscellaneous items. Originals, 2.5 cm (volumes 10-11).

Include engagement books, valentines, picture postcards and family snapshots. Also a letter from a sister of Agnes Macphail and some biographical information.

Agnes Macphail Papers (1921-1945)

Agnes Campbell Macphail (1890-1954) was born on a farm in Grey County, Ontario. After attending High School at Owen Sound and Stratford and Stratford Normal College, she taught in rural schools for eight years before entering politics.

In the federal election of 1921 Agnes Macphail, a U.F.O. candidate, became the first Canadian woman M.P., representing South East Grey. She was re-elected by the same constituency in 1925, 1926 and 1930. Always impatient of the party system, Agnes Macphail was one of the first supporters of the C.C.F. party but when it seemed to her too radical she withdrew and was elected as a U.F.O. - Labour candidate in Grey-Bruce in 1935. She was defeated by a Liberal, Walter Harris, in 1940, but from 1943 until her death in 1954 she was a member of the Ontario legislature, representing York East as a C.C.F. candidate.

In 1929 Agnes Macphail was appointed as a Canadian delegate to the League of Nations Assembly and she was a member of the Committee on Disarmament. In 1937 she toured Denmark, Sweden and Russia.

Agnes Macphail regarded herself as a spokesman for the Canadian farmer and the Canadian woman, and an advocate for the common people, particularly the underdog. She was an active supporter of the cooperative movement from 1919 and was a director of the United Farmers Cooperative Co. Other subjects in which she had a particular interest were penal reform, marketing of agricultural products, monetary reform, rural education and public health. A favorite topic for her speeches was the role of women in society.
