A member of the House of Lords and lord-in-waiting to Queen Victoria, Lord Dufferin became a diplomatic attaché during the Vienna Conference following the Crimean War. After numerous diplomatic postings, he entered William Gladstone's government as Chancellor of the Duchy of Lancaster. In June 1872, Lord Dufferin was appointed Governor General of Canada, a position which he retained until November of 1878. Until his retirement from public life in 1895, he was in turn the British Ambassador at St. Petersburg, Administrator of Egypt, Viceroy of India, Ambassador to Rome and Ambassador to Paris.

Portions of the Dufferin Papers relating to Canada were microfilmed in 1959 from originals in the Public Record Office of Northern Ireland (reels A-406 to A-421). The microfilms were photocopied in 1978 by the National Archives of Canada (volumes 2-12).

Originals and photocopies (vol. 1) were obtained from various sources: the Ottawa Historical Society in 1968 (file 11), Joan Enders in 1972, 1975 and 1978 (files 1-4, 9), W. Myers in 1978 (file 2), Olive Boswell in 1979 (file 6), Guy Smith in 1982 (file 5) and copies from the P.R.O. of Northern Ireland in 1959 (files 7-8) and in 1988 (files 12-24).

No Restriction on Access.

The Finding Aid No. 127 consists of a general description of the contents of each microfilm reel including dates and extent, as well as a file list giving dates and extent of all original and photocopied documents.

#### NOTES ON FINDING AID

- 1. The microfilm portion of this collection was made by the Public Record Office in Northern Ireland in 1959 and contains items, selected from their larger Dufferin and Ava collection, which relate to Lord Dufferin's years in Canada, 1872-1878.
- 2. Items microfilmed by the Public Record Office of Northern Ireland were not numbered consecutively before microfilming, therefore, page numbers referred to in this finding aid relate solely to the original internal numbering in Letterbooks, Entry Books, and other collected documents. This explains the irregular numbering of pages in each microfilm reel.
- 3. Documents on microfilm have in some cases been poorly arranged and have not been organized either strictly chronologically, or by author or subject. The researcher should be aware that material tends to be arranged according to the format of the document, e.g. Entry Book, Draft letters, etc. Thus, there has been some duplication of manuscripts and a letter may appear in more than one location in the collection. For example, a copy of a letter to Sir John A. Macdonald, 19 October 1873, is found in correspondence section, "Lord Dufferin to the Prime Minister", and another copy with "Miscellaneous Correspondence, Outward-General correspondence". Researchers should keep this information in mind while using the collection.
- 4. Descriptive headings of sub-series in the microfilm portion of the collection are occasionally misleading due to inconsistencies in the organization of the manuscripts. For example, the correspondence subseries entitled "Lord Dufferin to the Colonial Secretary, 1872-1878" contains a few letters to Lord Dufferin which were mistakenly microfilmed with this series of out-going correspondence. The researcher will find inconsistencies such as these noted in the finding aid.
