Douglas V. LePan was born in 1914 in Toronto and was educated at the University of Toronto and Oxford University. He lectured at the University of Toronto, 1937-38, and at Harvard University, 1938-41. He served in World War II as an education adviser to General A.G.L. McNaughton, 1942-43 and later as an artillery officer until his discharge in 1945. In that year he joined the Department of External Affairs and until 1948 was on staff of the Canadian High Commission in London. After a one year leave of absence for study, he served as special assistant to the Minister of External Affairs, Lester B. Pearson, during 1950-51. From 1951 to 1955 he was Minister Counsellor in Washington after which he served for three years as secretary and Director of Research for the Royal Commission on Canada's Economic Prospects. He was Assistant Undersecretary of State for External Affairs, 1958-59 before becoming Professor of Literature at Queen's University in 1959, a position he held until 1964. He has twice won the Governor-General's Award for Literature, for poetry in 1954 and for fiction in 1964.

Transferred from Department of External Affairs, 1970.

The papers consist of files collected during his career with the Department of External Affairs, 1945-1959, and they include correspondence, despatches, telegrams, speeches, memoranda and clippings while he served in London, Washington and Ottawa, (volumes 1-11).
