MONK, James and family

Originals, 1735-1936. 106 cm. Finding Aid No. 286.

James Monk (ca.1707-1768) was Assistant Surveyor of Nova Scotia and a judge of the Superior Court of Common Pleas, 1749-1759, and at various times served as Solicitor General. His son, Sir James Monk (1745-1826) was Solicitor General of Nova Scotia, 1776-1789; Attorney General of Lower Canada, 1792-1794; Chief Justice of Lower Canada, 1794-1824; member of the Executive and Legislative Councils, and Administrator of the province, 1819-1820. His brother, George Henry Monk (1748-1823) was First Justice of the Court of Common Pleas of Nova Scotia, 1799-1801, and Puisné Judge of the Supreme Court of Nova Scotia, 1801-1816. His son, Samuel Wentworth Monk (1792-1865) was protonotary of the Court of Queen's Bench at Montreal, 1815-1865, and his grandson George Henry Monk (1822-c.1870) purchased the Seigneury de Blainville in 1846. The seigneury remained in the family until the 1930's when the land was subdivided and sold.

Finding Aid No. 286 provides a detailed shelf list of the papers in volumes 1-8 with a correlation of volume and pages numbers to microfilm reel numbers; and a descriptive list of files 1-26 arranged alphabetically by author and of files 27-30 by date. The listing for files 1-26 was included in the microfilming of the collection in 1960 (see reels C-1451 to C-1453 and C-1463). A file list only is available for volumes 9 and 10, and these volumes are not available on microfilm.

Correspondence and related papers of James Monk and his descendants, including their wives. The documents are arranged in files, titled according to the persons who accumulated them. The bulk of the collection concerns James Monk, his sons Sir James Monk and George Henry Monk and George's sons George Henry jr. and Samuel Wentworth Monk (volumes 1-8, files 1-30).

Acquired in 1959. A few small items were acquired in 1971-72 and 1978; further details are available in the finding aid.

Seigneurial records of the Seigneury de Blainville; family correspondence; legal records; account books; and, genealogical notes relating to various members of the Monk family,1817-1936. The majority of the documents pertain to George Henry Monk (b.1783), his wife Jane Pangman, their son George Henry Monk (1822-c.1870) the Seigneur de Blainville, his wife (and first cousin) Georgiana Henrietta Monk, their seven children and descendants (volumes 9 & 10).
