Robert Shore Milnes, Lieutenant Governor of Lower Canada, appointed June 1798, replacing General Prescott, the Governor General. Milnes arrived on June 13th 1799, when he took the oath of Office but as Lieutenant Governor did not assume the duties of Office until the departure of General Prescott. Milnes was made a Baronet in 1801 but was never made Governor General as Prescott in England retained the Office until 1807. Sir Robert S. Milnes remained in Quebec until August 1805.

This book is obviously a copy of Milnes Dispatches and may be all of them not classified as secret. The letters cover a wide range of subjects and throw considerable light on the questions of that time. General Prescott left a legacy of trouble concerning Crown Lands which Milnes handled with tact and avoided becoming entangled with it. There is considerable correspondence regarding Jesuit Estates, the Clergy, Catholic and Protestant; Land Grants, and colonization are dealt with at some length. His difficulties with Chief Justice Osgood and another member of the Judiciary are clearly and fairly reported.

On the whole Sir Robert Milnes work in Lower Canada conveys the impression of his being a loyal, conscientious, civil servant rather than an administrator.
