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MILNE, DAVID BROWN, Collection (1882-1953). Artist.

Originals, n.d., 1896-1966, 3 feet 1 inch.

David Milne was born near Paisley, Ontario. He taught school for a few years before leaving Canada for New York to study at the Art Students' League. He remained in New York painting and working as a commercial artist, and in 1913, five of his paintings were exhibited at the famous Armory Show there. In the late fall of 1917, Milne enlisted in the Canadian Army and a year later was appointed an official war artist. He spent the year following the Armistice painting the aftermath of war in France. After his return to the United States, Milne lived and painted with his wife May (Patsy) at Boston Corners in the Taconic Mountains, and in the Riga Lakes and Lake Placid Districts of New York State. In 1928, David Milne settled again in Canada, first in Weston, Ontario, then in Palgrave in the Caledon Hills, and later at Severn Falls and Six Mile Lake in the Muskoka District.

When the date on an undated letter has been inferred, the inferred date is given in square brackets, with the letter arranged in its proper chronological place. When there is some doubt about the certainty of an inferred date, the date given is followed by a question mark within the square brackets.
3. Correspondence received by James Clarke from David Milne is arranged in the boxes according to the manner in which it was numbered when first deposited in the Public Archives. However, a chronological list has been prepared and appears as an appendix to the finding aid.
4. The contents of volumes 9 and 10 have been described in the finding aid but access to these volumes is restricted.
