3. Maxse to - , Heligoland, 11 October 1870. Re claim of Heligoland against owner of fishing smack FLYING CLOUD, of Hull, his account expenses due to war, case of Mr. Callister, a money lender and a letter from Mr. Boyd re his expenses. 6 pages.
4. Maxse to - , Govt. House, Heligoland, 27 October 1871. Acknowledges letter and asks him to confine himself to the £1000. 2 pages.
5. Maxse to Chevalier [Kingston], Govt. House, 1 August 1872, encloses photographs, family affairs. 4 pages.
6. Maxse to - , Heligoland, 3 March 1873. Acknowledges letter, his estate, life insurance. 3 pages.
7. Maxse to - , Govt. House, Heligoland, 24 July 1875. Education of his son Ernest. 4 pages.
8. Maxse to Fladgate, United Service Club, Pall Mall, 1 April 1879. Re excessive baggage charges. Bremen to London. 4 pages.
9. Maxse to Fladgate, Charring Cross Hotel, 1 April 1879, his financial position and provisions for income from the will of his father.
10. Maxse to Fladgate, Heligoland, 30 April 1879. Details education of his sons in response to question from his mother, Lady Caroline, relayed through Fladgate. 4 pages.
11. Maxse to Fladgate, Heligoland, 8 May 1879. Opinions and conduct of his mother re education of his sons. 4 pages.
12. Maxse to Fladgate, Heligoland, 21 May 1879. education acct's for info of Lady Caroline, applied for position in Gold Coast on account of his bad financial position. 4 pages.
13. Maxse to Fladgate, Heligoland, 7 June 1879. Lady Caroline and education bills, possible move to Gold Coast, his finances.
14. Maxse to Fladgate, Government House, Heligoland, 3 July 1879. Re payment of baggage [referred to in no. 11 also] 3 pages.
15. Sworn deposition re wreck of FLYING CLOUD from Hull on west wide of Sandy Island, 8 October 1870, signed by Maxse, among others. With weal of Court of Session, Heligoland. 3 pages.
