DOUGHTY, Arthur George (1860-1936). Archivist, Historian.

Originals, 1828-1942, 1956. 1.16 m. Microfilm, 1902-1913. Reel M-2244. Finding Aid No. 372.

Born and educated in England, Sir Arthur Doughty came to Canada in 1886. After a number of years spent in journalism and in the Quebec Provincial Government service, he became Dominion Archivist in 1904, succeeding Douglas Brymner. He retired in 1935 and was created K.C.M.G. the same year.

Papers were acquired in 1938, 1950, 1976, and 1978. Volume 14 was transferred from the Canadian War Museum in 1986.

Finding Aid No. 372 is a detailed list, with partial list of the general correspondence and a complete list of the microfilmed correspondence.

Specific correspondence, 1908-1922. Originals, 10 cm (volume 1).

Correspondence with Sir Edmund Walker, 1908-1922, concerning a variety of topics generally relating to the Public Archives, the Champlain Society, the National Battlefields Commission, the Wolfe Memorial and the Quebec Centenary; arranged chronologically. Bound letter from Lieut. J.W. Webber, 1918, on the post-Armistice period in France and Germany.

General Correspondence, 1899-19042. Originals, 8 cm (volume 2).

Arranged chronologically except for a bound volume of letters dealing with the plans of Old Quebec, 1899-1902, Great War Trophies, 1916-1918, and Archives Acquisitions, 1911, 1928. Included are a few letters received by Lady Doughty, 1937-1942; two letters from George Durnford concerning a letter from Captain George Vardon to Colonel John Prince in 1838 (the Vardon letter is available in MG 19, F 24); one letter from George Parker /Winship/ concerning the loan of books at the John Carter Brown Library in Rhode Island, acquired in 1971. Also included are several letters transferred from the Public Records Division (RG 37) in 1977.

Subject Files, 1892-1935. Originals, 47 cm (volumes 2-7).

The files are titled as follows: Town of Pzenas, Brazil Centenary, 1922; Canadian Coat of Arms, 1905; W.W. Campbell's report on U.E. Doughty's own bound and printed copy of "Correspondance de Bougainville", which appeared as an appendix in his The Siege of Quebec and the Battle of the Plains (Quebec 1901), Volume 4, with corrections and notes on the text by M.R. de Kerallain. Transferred in 1976 from the Public Archives Library.

Additional, 1828-1937. Originals, 33.5 cm (volumes 10-14).

Correspondence and other documents relating to various projects and committees; personal and biographical documents including letters of congratulations, 1935; clippings, 1887-1936, and printed matter; original archival documents and transcripts; notes and memoranda relating to the Public Archives; notes and manuscripts of speeches; correspondence, illustrative material and drafts of his publications. Donated in 1976 by Mrs. Sybil Mathieu. 30 cm (volumes 10-11).

Athenaeum Club, London, England, 1923. Original, 1 cm (volume 11).

Invitations and invoices relating to Doughty's membership. Transferred in 1977 from RG 37.

Doughty's own bound and printed copy of "at the Sign of the Golden Dog" (1932). Also included in the volume are relevant illustrations. Transferred in June 1978 from the Public Archives Library. 2.5 cm (volume 12).

Unpublished bound manuscript by Doughty. Tour of the Prince of Wales in Canada, 1919. Typescript copy with handwritten editorial changes. 2.5 cm (Volume 13).

Appointment as Knight Commander of the Order of St. Michael and St. George, and souvenirs, 1956. 1 cm (volume 14).

Correspondence, 1902-1913. Microfilm, M-2244.

A collection of autograph letters signed of prominent persons including members of British nobility whose predecessors were active in Canadian affairs. Copied in 1972 from originals in the possession of McGill University.
