Born in Quebec City, William Wood was commissioned in the 8th Royal Rifles of Quebec in 1887. After commanding the unit from 1907 to 1910, he retired with the rank of colonel. Wood was an authority on North American military history and a prolific writer. He authored many books, including five volumes in the Chronicles of Canada series, and he compiled the Select British Documents of the Canadian War of 1812 which was published in three volumes by the Champlain Society between1920 and 1928. Wood was also interested in wildlife conservation and preservation of historic monuments and buildings. He served on both the Quebec and Canadian Landmarks Commissions and on the Town Planning Commission of Quebec City.

Presented in 1965 and 1969 by Mrs. L.S. Apedaile of Montreal. Photographs, maps and plans, and some printed matter have been transferred to the appropriate Divisions.

Letters received by Wood relating primarily to wildlife conservation, preservation of historic buildings in Quebec City and the publication of his books. Also of note is the correspondence in 1917 with Lord Grey, former Governor-General, and Arthur F. Sladen, private secretary to the then Governor-General, concerning the attitudes of French-Canadians toward participation in the defence of the British Empire in general and in the war effort specifically.

Reprints of Wood's addresses to the Canadian Conservation Commission advocating the establishment of animal sanctuaries in Labrador, 1911-1913, and the Royal Society of Canada on the St. Lawrence area, 1910. Miscellaneous pamphlets, journals, broadsides and clippings on the subject of conservation are also included.
