At the 1940 annual meeting of the National Council of the Y.M.C.A. the Executive Committee was instructed to appoint a commission to study and report on the social situation as it affected Canadian youth in the war period and to suggest recommendations on post-war adjustment. Dr. R.E.G. Davis, Personnel Director of the Y.M.C.A. since 1928, had taken a prominent part in framing the 1940 resolution. In 1942 he went on leave to become Director of the Canadian Youth Commission, which was formed in April, 1943. Dr. Sidney E. Smith, then President of the University of Manitoba, was appointed Chairman. The Y.M.C.A. assumed major responsibility for financing the work and selecting the nucleus of the Commission, and the National Council acted as trustees of the Commission's funds. Once formed, however, the Commission operated as an independent and autonomous body. Its objectives were the study of the needs and problems of young people between the ages of 15-24, the formulation of proposals relating to the welfare of this group in the post-war period, and the promotion of their acceptance by government and public and private agencies. Studies were undertaken under the main headings of "Education", "Employment", "Citizenship", "Health", "Family Living", "Recreation", and "Religion and Life Philosophy," and sub-committees were formed to deal with each of these fields. Provincial committees were established in every province to organize youth study groups, and youth conferences were held from coast to coast. Material was gathered by means of questionnaires, personal interviews, opinions of youth leaders, briefs and self-evaluations from youth groups, and special memoranda from experts. The Canadian Institute of Public

Opinion took a national poll of youth opinion. A series of twelve volumes of reports, published by Ryerson Press, was issued. The life of the Commission was originally set at two years, but the final reports were not issued until 1948. In 1946 Dr. Davis relinquished the post of Director to become Executive Director of the Canadian Welfare Council. The Records of the Commission came into the custody of the latter body, until 1959 when they were transferred to the Public Archives.
