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BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE ON CHARLES A.E. HARRISS

Dr. Charles Harriss was born in London, England and educated at St. Michael's College, Tenbury. He came to Canada in 1882 to become organist of Christ Church Cathedral, Montreal. In 1891 he began touring the United States and Canada as a concert artist, subsequently acting as tour manager for other artists and orchestras. He founded and directed the McGill University Conservatory of Music, 1904-1907, at the same time embarking upon his principal work, that of organizing and directing large choral and orchestral concerts throughout the British Empire, the United States and Europe. In 1909 Dr. Harriss founded the Imperial Choir, an organization comprising many smaller choirs, totalling 4500 singers.
