WEIR, E. AUSTIN (1886-1968). Broadcaster.

Originals, n.d., 1911-1968. 3.4m. Microfilm, 1923-1943, 4 reels, M-537, M-538, M-584, M-715. Finding Aid No. 463.

Born in Randwick, Ontario, and educated at OAC and University of Toronto, Weir went west in 1913 to work with the Farm and Ranch Review, and later the Nor'West Farmer and Grain Growers' Guide. While in Winnipeg he became associated with the Rural Credit Societies and later served as Chairman of the Board of Trustees and Manager of the Province of Manitoba Savings Office. In 1924 he joined the Colonization Department of Canadian National Railways in London, England, and was responsible for publicity in Britain and later, Europe. In 1929 he returned to Canada as Director of Radio for the CNR and was involved in a number of that company's early broadcasting successes. After serving briefly with the Canadian Radio Broadcasting Commission, Weir pursued private broadcasting, returning to the national network in 1937 after the organization of the CBC. During his CBC career Weir worked in various capacities including Commercial Manager and Supervisor of Press and Information. Following his retirement in 1956, Weir continued to act as a consultant and, in 1965, authored The Struggle for National Broadcasting in Canada.

Portions of Weir's papers were microfilmed by the PAC in 1961 and 1963. In 1966 and 1967 original material, some of which had previously been microfilmed, was presented by E.A. Weir. Another block of original material was given by the Weir family in 1970. In 1973 approximately 5cm. of original material was presented by the CBC Historical Section.

A number of photographs have been transferred to the National Photography Collection and books and pamphlets to the Public Archives Library. Academic Certification is preserved in the vertical file cabinet, Manuscript Division. A scroll honouring Weir on his retirement from the CBC and a Direct Mail Leaders Award 1942 are preserved in the horizontal file cabinet, Manuscript Division.

The Finding Aid No. 463 is a subject list for microfilm reels M-537, M-538, M-584, M-715 and a file list for volumes 1-34.

Papers relating to early broadcasting initiated by, and under the direction of, Canadian National Railways. Included are: radio programme schedules; daily station logs and announcer's scripts; correspondence, memoranda, articles, clippings and scripts relating to some of the more important events in CNR broadcasting history. Originals for much of this material will be found in the Subject Files Series.

Note on the Organization of the Papers:

The Weir Papers are a compilation of material from a number of accessions over the period 1961-1973 and, as such, their organization reflects this situation. In 1961 and 1963 material was forwarded by Weir to the PAC for microfilming and the originals returned to him. The originals presented to the Archives by Weir in 1966 and 1967 included certain material which had previously been microfilmed. However, because of the loss or addition of records between 1961-63 and 1966-67, the microfilm does not constitute an exact and complete copy of the original material; conversely, material may appear in the microfilm holdings but not in the originals. As a consequence, the researcher is advised to consult both the originals and the microfilm.

A second block of original material was presented by the Weir family in 1970, and arranged in two series - a Nominal Series and a Subject Series. The originals presented in 1966-67 have now been integrated into these series although files from the earlier accession have been kept distinct and are identified in the Finding Aid by an asterisk (*).

Similarly, the material presented by the C.B.C. Historical Section in 1973 has been integrated into the Subject Series and is identified in the Finding Aid by a double asterisk (**).

In the Finding Aid description of the microfilm, references to the location in the originals where similar and related material may be found, have been provided.
