

O'GORMAN, The Reverend Dr. John J., 1847-1868, 1925-1927. 8 inches.

The Reverend Dr. J.J. O'Gorman (1884-1933) was at one time attached to the Blessed Sacrament Parish, Ottawa. He also served as Chaplain of the Catholic Truth Society of Ottawa. His Papers were received in 1933?

The O'Gorman Papers consist of correspondence relating to the procurement of material for a work on Thomas D'Arcy McGee; copies of lectures on D'Arcy McGee; transcripts of McGee correspondence, poems, articles and speeches; notes and clippings used in the compilation of articles and lectures on McGee; photostat copies of scattered issues of The Nation and The American Celt; and miscellaneous articles on McGee.
