

Storker T. Storkerson: 1914-19198 Vols. <sup>10 cm</sup> ~~1 ft. 3 in.~~

Diaries of Storker T. Storkerson of Norway, a member of the Canadian Arctic Expedition of 1913-1918 commanded by Vihljalmur Stefansson. He had accompanied Stefansson on his earlier expeditions of 1906-1907 and 1908-1912. After the departure of George H. Wilkins in 1916 he became ranking member of the expedition. In 1915 and 1917 he traversed the north coast of Victoria Island, and in 1918, when Stefansson was ill, he took charge of the ice drift party that explored the Beaufort Sea North of Alaska.
