MALCOLM, JAMES, (1880-1935). Manufacturer and Minister.

Originals, 1922-1935, 1.5 meters. Finding aid No. 517.

James Malcolm was born at Kincardine Ontario and was educated at Upper Canada College. He became a furniture manufacturer in Kincardine and served as councillor and mayor of that community. He was first elected to the House of Commons in 1921 for Bruce North and represented the constituency until 1935 when he retired from the Commons. He served as Minister of Trade and Commerce in the Mackenzie King government from 1926 to 1930.

His papers were presented to the Public Archives by his widow in 1951. Most of the papers relate to Trade and Commerce matters.

The finding aid consists of a file list for all volumes and a nominal list of correspondents for volumes 1-4.

Letter to Mrs. Malcolm from the Director of Publicity, Department of Trade and Commerce, enclosing clippings reporting the death of Malcolm.
