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GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE PAPERS

Although the papers have been arranged in a number of series, the arrangement is arbitrary. Many items could have been placed elsewhere in the collection. In the series "Miscellaneous Bound Volumes" in particular, a variety of items were originally placed in some volumes. It was thought better to retain the volumes in their original form rather than to try to separate and refile individual items.

HEENEY, W. Bertal. 1873-1955. Clergyman, author.

Rev. Canon W. Bertal A. Heeneey was born at Danford Lake, Quebec. He graduated from McGill University in 1899 and went on to the Montreal Diocesan College for his theological training. His first charge was as rector of Christ Church in Belleville, Ontario (1901-1905). Then he spent two years at St. George's Protestant Episcopal Church, Newport, Rhode Island, and two years at Trinity Church, Barrie, Ontario before moving to St. Luke's Church, Winnipeg, in 1909. He remained there until his retirement in 1942. He then taught Church history at Trinity College, University of Toronto after which he took up residence in Ottawa. He died 14 April 1955.

Canon Heeneey, in addition to his clerical work, was known for his writings on church history and theology. Among his works were: The Essential Unity of the Churches, Leaders of the Canadian Church, and I Walk With a Bishop. He also wrote three novels: Pickanock, D'Arcy Conyers, and Unto the Hills.
