Henry Cull (1753-1833), a native of Dorset, England, settled at Quebec about 1784 where he was a prominent merchant and land speculator. In 1806 Cull settled in Hatley Township, developing his property there and serving Justice of the Peace and Lt.-Col. of the Militia.

Deposited in the Public Archives in 1949 by Richard Perley Cull of Seba Beach, Alta., who retained the rights of ownership.

Finding Aid No. 36 provides a descriptive list of the documents and an alphabetical index of the letterbooks.

Miscellaneous documents relating to Hatley Township, 1799-1839, together with letterbooks of Henry Cull, 1796-1812, and a letterbook for the Eastern Townships Militia, 1807-1824. The papers contain information about business affairs, land speculation and the course of the War of 1812. Also available on microfilm reel M-142.
