BROCK, Sir Isaac, 1769, 1805-1812, 1846.

Major-General Sir Isaac Brock, (1769-1812).
A career soldier, Brock first came to Canada for a brief stay in 1802. Returning in 1804 he was in command of Quebec until 1810 and from 1810 until his death at Queenston in 1812, Brock was Commander of His Majesty's Forces in Upper Canada. The majority of the papers is correspondence from Sir George Prevost to Brock from 22 June 1812 to 28 Sept. 1812.
